(Under section 95)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 95 of the Magistrate's Court Act, 1938, I hereby issue the following Notice —

1. This Notice may be cited as the Tariff of Fees of Messengers (Amendment) Notice, 1982.

Replacement of Table B.

2. Table B of the Second Annexure to the Magistrate's Court Rules, 1938 is replaced with the following—
