THE RATING ACT (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE) NOTICE, 1987

(Under Section 2)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Rating Act 1967, the Prime Minister hereby issues the following Notice—

Citation

1. This Notice may be cited as the Rating Act (Amendment of Schedule) Notice, 1987 and shall come into force on the 22nd May, 1987 and shall be read as one with the Rating Act 1967 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act").

THE UMBUTFO SWAZILAND DEFENCE FORCE ORDER, 1977

(Order No. 10 of 1977)

THE UMBUTFO SWAZILAND DEFENCE FORCE (REMUNERATION)
REGULATIONS, 1987

(Under Section 34)

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 34 of the Umbutfo Swaziland Defence Force Order 1977, I MSWATI III, on the advice of the Army Commander, hereby make the following Regulations—

Citation and Commencement.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Umbutfo Swaziland Defence Force (Remuneration) Regulations, 1987 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st April, 1987.

Remuneration of Members of the Defence Force.

2. The remuneration of the members of the Umbutfo Swaziland Defence Force shall be as set out in the schedule hereto.

Revocation of Legal Notice No. 65 of 1986.

3. The Umbutfo Swaziland Defence Force (Remuneration) Regulations, 1986 are hereby revoked.

THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION ACT, 1983

(Act No. 7 of 1983)

THE WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION (MEDICAL EXPENSES)
REGULATIONS, 1987

(Under section 45)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 45 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1983, the Minister for Labour after consultations with the Minister for Health, hereby makes the following Regulation:

Citation and commencement.

1. These Regulations shall be cited as the Workmen's Compensation (Medical Expenses) Regulation, 1987 and shall come into force on the 1st June, 1987.

Medical expenses payable by employer.

2. The limit of medical expenses to be paid by an employer on behalf of a workman is increased by 15% from E5,550 to E6,325.
