THE APPROPRIATION ACT, 1988

(Act No. 4 of 1988)



I ASSENT

MSWATI III KING OF SWAZILAND

26th May, 1988

AN ACT

entitled

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1988 and ending on the 31st March, 1989.

ANACTED by the King and the Parliament of Swaziland.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1988 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st April, 1988.

Charge to Consolidated Fund.

2. The Consolidated Fund is charged with such sum of money not exceeding in the aggregate three hundred and forty-six million, two hundred and thirty-nine thousand Emalangeni (E346,239,000) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland during the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1988 and ending on the 31st March, 1989.

Application of sum appropriated.

The sum appropriated under section 2 shall be applied to the services set out in the
First column of the Schedule and in the respective amounts appearing in the second and
third columns in respect of each service.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 51 OF 1988

ANIMAL DISEASE ACT, 1965

(Act No. 7 of 1965)

THE STOCK DISEASE (RABIES) (NO. 2) REGULATIONS, 1988

(Under section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 3 of the Stock Disease Act, 1967 the Minister for Agriculture and Co-operatives hereby makes the following Regulations—

Citation.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Stock Disease (Rabies) (No. 2) Regulations, 1988 and shall come into force on the 3rd June, 1988.

Declaration of rabies guard areas.

2. The dipping tanks and other areas specified in Schedule 1 hereto are hereby declared to be Rabies Guard Areas.

Isolation and confinement of dogs in rabies guard areas.

 An owner of a dog in any of the guard areas shall isolate and confine it so as to prevent it from escaping from that area.

Destruction of dogs in rabies guard areas.

4. A Government veterinary Officer may destroy a dog in any of the Rabies Guard Areas which in his opinion has not been confined so as to prevent it from escaping from that area.

Presentation of dogs for innoculation.

5. A person who live within a rabies guard area and owns a dog shall present it at the innoculation centre mentioned in Schedule II hereto for innoculation by the Director of Veterinary Services or his duly authorised agent during the time specified therein.

Offence and penalty.

6. Every owner of a dog in any of the guard areas who contravens or fails to comply with regulation 3 shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of E300.00 or imprisonment for a period of six months.
