# THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963 (Act No. 35 of 1963)

# THE APPOINTMENT OF THE NATIONAL STEERING COMMITTEE ON THE UNIVERSAL PERIODIC REVIEW NOTICE, 2011 (Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister for Justice and Constitutional Affairs issues this Notice -

#### Citation and Commencement

- 1. (I) This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the National Steering Committee on Universal Periodic Review Notice, 2011.
  - (2) This Notice shall be deemed to have come into force on the 24th March, 2011.

#### Establishment of the Committee

2. There is established a Committee to be known as the National Steering Committee on the Universal Periodic Review (hereinafter referred to as the Committee).

#### Composition of the Committee

#### Functions of the Committee

- 4. The Committee shall perform the following functions -
  - (a) Conduct consultations with stakeholders on the Human Rights situation in Swaziland;
  - (b) Conduct national consultations on the Human Rights situation in Swazilland;
  - (c) Prepare and present a draft national report on Human Rights for consideration by Cabinet;
  - (d) Present the National report to the Human Rights Council;
  - (e) Prepare responses for Cabinet approval to advance questions received from the Human Rights Council;
  - (f) Present the recommendations of the Human Rights Council to Cabinet for consideration; and
  - (g) Prepare Cabinet response to the recommendations of the Human Rights Council for presentation to the plenary of the Human Rights Council.

#### Frequency of Meetings

5. The Committee shall meet at such places and times as the chairman may determine.

### Term of office

6. The Committee shall remain in office until the 4th October, 2011.

### Sub-Committee of the Committee

7. The Committee may constitute itself into sub-committees as amd when the need arises.

#### Allowances

8. The Committee shall be entitled to such allowances and where applicable re-imbursement for travelling expenses in accordance with the applicable Finance circular.

# Extension of term of appointment

9. The Minister may by notice in the gazette extend the term of office.
