LEGAL NOTICE NO. 118 OF 2012

THE ANIMAL DISEASES ACT, 1965 (Act No. 7 of 1965)

THE STOCK DISEASES REGULATIONS, 2012 (Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Animal Diseases Act, 1965, the Minister for Agriculture issues the following regulations -

Citation and Commencement

- 1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Stock Diseases Regulations, 2012.
 - (2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 13th August 2012.

Declaration of rabies guard areas

2. The areas specified in the Schedule attached hereto are declared to be Rabies Guard Areas.

Isolation and Confinement of dogs

An owner of a dog or cat in a guard area shall isolate and confine the dog or cat as to prevent
it from escaping from such guard area and that confinement and isolation shall remain in force until
further notice.

Presentation of dogs and cats for vaccination

4. An owner of a dog or a cat who lives within the areas specified in the schedule shall present the dog or cat for inoculation at the designated vaccination centre at the time specified in the schedule.

Offences and penalties

5. An owner of a dog or a cat who fails to comply with these regulations commits an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding E300.00 and in default of payment, to imprisonment for a period not exceeding 3 months.

Destruction of dogs and cats in rabies guard areas

- 6. (1) A Government Veterinary Officer may destroy a dog or a cat in any of the Rabies Guard Areas if in his opinion the dog or cat has not been confined so as to prevent it from escaping from that guard area.
- (2) In pursuance of sub-regulation (1), a Government Veterinary Officer may ask for assistance of the Royal Swaziland Police in carrying out the provision of these regulations.
