#### THE APPROPRIATION (1979/80) BILL, 1979

(Bill No. 1 of 1979)

(To be presented by the Minister for Finance)

Memorandum in terms of the Standing Orders of Parliament.

The object of this Bill is to charge the Consolidated Fund with the sum of one hundred and fifty eight million, six hundred and seventy thousand Emalangeni (E158,675,000) for the period commencing on the 1st April, 1979 and ending on the 31st March, 1980.

The sum is to be appropriated in the manner set out in the Schedule hereto.

#### A BILL

#### entitled

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1979 and ending on the 31st March, 1980.

ENACTED by the King and the Parliament of Swaziland.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as The Appropriation (1979/80) Act, 1979 and shall come into force on the 1st day of April, 1979.

Charge to Consolidated Fund.

2. The Consolidated Fund is charged with such sum of money not exceeding in the aggregate one hundred and fifty-eight million, six hundred and seventy-five thousand Emalangeni (E158,675,000) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland during the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1979 and ending on the 31st March, 1980.

Application of Sum appropriated.

3. The sum appropriated by section 2 shall be applied to the services set out in the first column of the Schedule and in the respective amounts appearing in the second and third columns in respect of each service.
