# AN ACT entitled

An Act to provide for the appropriation of a certain sum of money for the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1984 and ending on the 31st March, 1985.

ENACTED by the Regent and the Parliament of Swaziland.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation Act, 1984 and shall come into force on the 1st of April, 1984.

Charge to the Consolidated Fund.

- 2. The Consolidated Fund is charged with such sum not exceeding in the aggregate two hundred and eleven million, eight hundred and nine thousand Emalangeni (211,809,000) as required for the services of the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland during the financial year commencing on the 1st April, 1984 and ending on the 31st March, 1985.
- 3. The sum appropriated under section 2 shall be applied on the services set out in the first column of the Schedule and in the respective amounts appearing in the second and third columns in respect of each services.

# THE LOANS (NAVIGATIONAL AIDS AND RAILWAY EQUIPMENT) ACT, 1984

(Act No. 2 of 1984)

# AN ACT entitled

An Act to authorise the raising of loans from the Government of the French Republic for the purposes of purchasing navigational aids for Matsapha Airport and railway equipment for Swaziland Railway.

ENACTED by the Regent and the Parliament of Swaziland.

### Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Loans (Navigational Aids and Railway Equipment) Act, 1984.

### Interpretation.

- 2. In this Act unless the context otherwise requires
  - "Agreement" means the Agreement referred to under section 3 and includes any documents relevant thereto;
  - "loans" means the loans raised by the Minister in terms of section 3;
  - "Minister" means the Minister responsible for Public Finance.

### Authority to raise loans.

- 3. The Minister is hereby authorised to enter into an Agreement with the Government of the French Republic for the purpose of raising the following loans
  - (a) a loan of twelve million five hundred thousand French francs (Ff. 12,500,000) approximately one million eight hundred and forty seven thousand, one hundred and ninety two Emalangeni (E1,847,192) with interest and repayment terms as set out in section 4;

(b) a loan of twelve million five hundred thousand French francs (Ff. 12,500,000) approximately one million, eight hundred and forty seven thousand, one hundred and ninety two Emalangeni (E1,847,192) with interest and repayment terms as set out in section 5.

Loan charges and repayments.

- 4. (1) The loan referred to in section 3(a) shall carry an interest rate of three percent (3%) per annum on the principal amount disbursed and outstanding from time to time.
  - (2) The interest shall be payable semi-annually in arrears.
- (3) The loan shall be repayable over a period of thirty years in forty consecutive annual instalments, the first instalment falling due ten and a half  $(10\frac{1}{2})$  years after the end of the quarter during which the first drawing of the loan was made, irrespective of the amount of such drawing.
- (4) The loan shall be subject to such other terms and conditions as may be agreed between the Government of the French Republic and the Government of Swaziland.
- 5. (1) The loan referred to in section 3(b) shall carry interest at the prevailing rate for French export credits on the principal amount disbursed and outstanding from time to time.
  - (2) the interest shall be payable semi-annually in arrears.
- (3) the loan shall be repayable over a period of ten years in twenty equal and consecutive semi-annual instalments, the first instalment falling due on the contractual date of completion of the purchase referred to in section 7, or on such earlier date as may be agreed between the Government of the French Republic and the Government of Swaziland.

Charging of loans.

6. The loans shall be charged upon the Consolidated Fund and assets of the Government of Swaziland.

Applications of loans,

7. The proceeds of the loans shall be used by the Government of Swaziland for the purpose of purchasing French manufactured navigational aids for Matsapha Airport and railway equipment for Swaziland Railway.
