GENERAL NOTICE NO. 26 OF 1986

THE CENTRAL BANK OF SWAZILAND ORDER, 1974

(King's Order-in-Council No. 6 of 1974)

THE CHARACTERISTICS OF TWENTY EMALANGENI NOTE TO BE ISSUED BY THE CENTRAL BANK OF SWAZILAND

(Under Section 24(3))

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 24(3) of the Central Bank of Swaziland Order, 1974, I hereby issue the following Notice—

Citation.

1. This Notice may be cited as "Characteristics of the Twenty Emalangeni note to be issued by the Central Bank of Swaziland".

Currency.

2. The Twenty Emalangeni note to be issued by the Central Bank of Swaziland in terms of this General Notice shall be legal tender in terms of Section 23 of the Central Bank of Swaziland Order. The Twenty Emalangeni note issued in accordance with General Notice No. 157 of 1975 also continues to be legal tender in Swaziland.

Denomination, Size, Weights and Back Ground Colour of Note.

3. The note shall consist of mould-made banknote paper with melamine incorporation a watermark and a metal security thread, and shall be of the following denomination, size, weight and background colour:-

Design and inscription of Note.

- 4. The note will bear the following designs and inscriptions:
 - (1) on the obverse side of the 20 (twenty) Emalangeni note shall be printed and inscribed:
 - (a) to the left of the centre the printed image of His Majesty King Mswati III.
 - (b) to the right of the centre in a white blank a watermark representing a Swazi shield complete with two spears and a stick;
 - (c) at the top and centrally printed the words "CENTRAL BANK OF SWA-ZILAND" and below that the words "THIS NOTE IS LEGAL TENDER FOR" in capital Roman letters;
 - (d) in the centre the image of a Swazi Shield horizontally printed complete with two spears and a stick with feathers, and in the centre of the Swazi Shield the number 20 (twenty) in Arabic numerals;
 - (e) around the shield, following the curve of the shield and at the top the words in capital Roman letters printed "LANGEMASHUMI LAMABILI";
 - (f) around the shield, following the curve of the shield at the bottom printed in capital Roman letters the word "EMALANGENI";
 - (g) at the bottom centre the image of an elephant with its trunk raised;
 - (h) below the image of His Majesty Mswati III, the image of a lion with its left paw raised;
 - (i) on the top left hand and on the bottom right hand corner, the printed value (20) twenty in Arabic numerals;
 - (j) at the bottom, below the image of His Majesty King Mswati III and at the top above the watermark, printed serial numbers;
 - (k) at both extreme ends of the note an E shaped geometrical design;
 - (l) at the right hand end the image of a walking stick;
 - (m) to the bottom of the watermark, the image of the Kingdom's Houses of Parliament;
 - (n) slightly to the top and on the left of the watermark a circle with geometrical design;
 - (o) a Security metal thread embedded in the paper of the note;
 - (p) below the image of the Houses of Parliament a reprint of the signatures of the Minister for Finance and the Governor of the Central Bank;

- (q) at the upper and lower ends of the note a border of beadwork which shows also on the reverse side;
- (r) on the left and right hand ends of the note a geometrical design with the basic background colour of each note bordered on the upper and lower ends by the beadwork referred to in paragraph 4 (1)(q) which shows also on the reverse side.
- (2) On the reverse side of the 20 (twenty) Emalangeni note shall be printed and inscribed;
 - (a) at the top of the note and below the beadwork a band in a darker shade of the basic colour with the inscription "20" in Arabic numerals and the the words "CENTRAL BANK OF SWAZILAND" in capital Roman letters:
 - (b) the watermark referred to in paragraph 4(1) (b) on the left in a square white blank;
 - (c) at the bottom above the beadwork a band in a colour similar to that referred to in paragraph 4(2) (a) bordered by the beadwork on either side;
 - (d) at the bottom left line with the band referred to in paragraph 4(2)(c) the inscription "20 TWENTY EMALANGENI";
 - (e) at the bottom right in line with the band referred to in paragraph 4(2)(c) the inscription "20" in Arabic numerals;
 - (f) between the two bands referred to in paragraph 4(2)(a) and 4(2)(c) a picture depicting pineapple, sugar cane, citrus, cotton, cattle, pine trees and mealie the major agricultural products in the Kingdom.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO SUBMIT WAGES REGULATION PROPOSALS (Under Section 11)

In accordance with the above Act, the Forestry and Forest Industry Wages Council, having made such investigations as it deemed fit, hereby publishes its intention to submit proposals to the Honourable Minister for Labour and Public Service as to the minimum wage and conditions of employment which should be applied to certain employees in relation to whom the Council operates.
