# TERMS OF REFERENCE OF THE DELIMITATION COMMISSION APPOINTMENT UNDER LEGAL NOTICE NO. 45 OF 1993

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 11 of the Establishment of the Parliament of Swaziland Order, 1992, I, MSWATI III, KING OF SWAZILAND hereby issue the terms of reference of the Delimitation Commission appointed under Legal Notice No. 45 of 1993.

### Citation

- 1. This Notice may be cited as the Delimitation Commission Terms of Reference Notice, 1993.
- ns of Reference.
- 2. The Terms of Reference of the Commission shall be as follows:-
  - (a) To redefine existing boundaries of the Tinkhundla, taking into account population density and topography in such a manner that the total number of Tinkhundla does not exceed fifty five.
  - (b) In carrying out its functions, the Commission shall not take into account boundaries of Chiefdoms. Only Regional boundaries shall be respected.
  - (c) Where necessary and appropriate, the Commission shall define one or more polling divisions within an Inkhundla.
  - (d) Wherever necessary and practicable, the Commission shall hear oral evidence and/or conduct an on the ground inspection of the area concerned.
  - (e) The Commission shall report to the King within four weeks from the date of appointment.
