THE FINANCE AND AUDIT ACT, 1967 (Act No. 18 of 1967)

THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE WATER RELIEF FUND REGULATIONS, 1996 (Under Section 12)

In the exercise of the powers conferred by Section 12 of the Finance and Audit Act, 1967 the Minister for Finance hereby makes the following regulations:-

Citation.

 The Regulations may be cited as the Administration of the Water Relief Fund Regulations, 1996.

Water Relief Fund.

- The following Regulations shall apply to the Water Relief Fund established under Notice No. 149 of 1995.
 - a) The Fund shall be in the name of Swaziland and shall be operational for three (3) years.
 - b) There shall be paid into the Fund, moneys specifically appropriated to finance relief water programmes including donor finance and moneys received as donations or grants.
 - c) The Fund shall be operated by the Accountant General with an account kept with the Central Bank.
 - d) All approved expenditure related to Water Relief shall be charged to the Fund in accordance with Government Accounting procedures.
 - e) All claims relating to the Fund shall be cleared within six months after expenditure has been incurred.
 - f) The PBC will recommend the projects for approval.
 - g) Allocations will be approved by the Cabinet Water committee on recommendation by the Minister for Finance.
