GENERAL NOTICE NO. 7 OF 1997

IN THE INDUSTRIAL COURT OF SWAZILAND

HELD AT MBABANE ON THE 1ST FEBRUARY, 1997 BEFORE THE HONOURABLE MARTIN S. BANDA, PRESIDENT OF THE INDUSTRIAL COURT SITTING WITH TWO NOMINATED MEMBERS

COURT ORDER

HAVING HEARD COUNSEL for the Applicant,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

A rule nisi do issue, with immediate effect, directed against the Swaziland Federation of Trade Unions and every trade union affiliated thereto and every official or member of the said Federation or Trade Union restraining them and interdicting them from engaging, instigating, promoting and/or calling for the strike action being the so called "stay-away" threatened and called for to take place and/or to commence on Monday the 3rd February, 1997.

We order that the said strike called for by the Swaziland Federation of Trade Unions to commence on the 3rd of February, 1997 is hereby declared unlawful and a threat to the national interest.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT all persons are interdicted from participating in the said strike.

This rule nisi is returnable on the 20th February, 1997.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT if any interested party intends to show cause and to oppose the confirmation of the rule, such party shall serve its Answering Affidavit on or before the 7th February, 1997 and the Applicant shall reply on or before the 14th February, 1997.
