### MEMORANDUM OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to amend the Swaziland Posts and Telecommunications Corporation Act, 1983, so as to make proper provision for the licencing of cellular phone communications in Swaziland.

## A BILL entitled

An Act to amend the Swaziland Posts and Telecommunications Corporation Act, 1983.

ENACTED by the King and the Parliament of Swaziland.

Short title and commencement.

1. This Act may be cited as the Swaziland Posts and Telecommunications Corporation (Amendment) Bill, 1998, and shall be read as one with the Swaziland Posts and Telecommunications Corporation Act, 1983 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act") and shall come into force on such date as the Minister may, by notice in the Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of Section 59.

- 2. Section 59 of the principal Act is amended by replacing paragraph (b) of subsection (1) (ii) with the following:
  - "(b) for the purpose of telephone communication by members of the public between any places within or outside of Swaziland."
