LEGAL NOTICE NO. 35 OF 2001

THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963

THE COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY INTO THE SWAZILAND ELECTRICITY BOARD (SEB) (EXTENSION OF TIME) NOTICE, 2001 (Under Sections 4 and 5)

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 3 and 5 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963 the Minister for Natural Resources and Energy hereby issues the following Notice:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Commission of Enquiry into the Swaziland Electricity Board (SEB) (Extension of Time) Notice, 2001 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 5th March, 2001.

Extension of time

2. The time within which the Commission shall submit its report is extended from the 30th day of November 2000 to the 13th July, 2001.

LEGAL NOTICE NO. 38 OF 2001

THE FINANCE MANAGEMENT AND AUDIT ACT, 1967 (Act No. 18 of 1967)

ADMINISTRATION OF THE SIBHIMBI FUND REGULATIONS, 2001 (Under Sections 12)

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 12 of the Finance Management and Audit Act, 1967, the Minister for Finance hereby issues the following Regulations:

Citation

The Regulations may be cited as the Administration of the Sibhimbi Fund Regulations, 2001.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:

"Fund" means the Sibhimbi Fund established under Legal Notice No. 47 of 2000.

Administration

- 3. (1) The Fund shall be in the name of the Government of Swaziland.
- (2) There shall be paid into the Fund donations and grants received from governments and individuals.
- (3) The Fund shall be operated by the Accountant General with an account kept with the Central Bank of Swaziland and all interest shall accrue to the Fund.
- (4) All approved expenditure on national celebrations shall be charged to the Fund in accordance with government accounting procedures.
- (5) A Committee of three persons comprising of representatives from the Ministry of Finance, Treasury Department and the Ministry responsible for national celebrations shall be responsible for the administration of the Fund and shall approve all claims relating to the Fund.
- (6) The Committee shall be chaired by the Principal Secretary of the Ministry responsible for celebrations or his representative.
- (7) The Principal Secretary of the Ministry responsible for national celebrations shall prepare and present reports to the Principal Secretary in the Ministry of Finance three months after the end of the Financial Year.

Auditing of the Fund

4. The Fund shall be audited by the Auditor General.

Annual Reports of the Fund

5. Annual reports of the Fund shall be laid by the Minister for Finance before Parliament six months after the end of the Financial Year.
