# THE COMMISSIONS OF ENQUIRY ACT, 1963 (Act No. 35 of 1963)

# THE APPOINTMENT OF THE JOB CREATION STEERING COMMITTEE NOTICE, 2005 (Under Section 3)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Commissions of Enquiry Act, 1963, the Minister for Enterprise and Employment hereby issues the following Notice:

# Citation and Commencement

1. This Notice may be cited as the Appointment of the Job Creation Steering Committee Notice, 2005 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17th May, 2005

# Establishment and Composition of Committee

2. There is established a Committee to be known as the Job Creation Steering Committee (herein referred to as "the Committee") which shall be composed of the following persons -

# Functions of the Committee

- 3. The Committee shall perform the following functions -
  - (i) resource mobilization

- (ii) stakeholder consultations.
- (iii) monitoring and implementing decisions taken during the Job Creation summit.
- (iv) education the nation, using all the Tinkhundla centres, on the objectives and decisions of the Job Creation Summit.
  - (v) receive and scrutinise applications for business start-up loans.
  - (vi) preparation of Summit reports and submission to Cabinet sub-committee (chairman and Secretariat).
  - (vii) providing linkages with the E1 Billion Job Creation Investment Committee.
  - (viii) preparation of topics and issues for discussion for education sessions.

### Duration

- 4. (I) The duration of the committee shall be a period of 16 weeks.
  - (II) Notwithstanding subsection (1), the Minister may by published notice Published in the gazette, extend the period of the enquiry.

#### Allowances

5. The Committee shall be entitled to such allowances and, where applicable, re-imbursement for travelling expenses in accordance with Finance Circular No. 4 of 1998

# Frequency of meetings

6. The Committee shall meet once a week and as often as it may be necessary to carry out its functions.

### **Quorum**

7. The chairperson and eight members shall constitute a quorum.

## Report

8. The Committee shall submit a report on its functions to the Minister on Job Creation every 2 weeks from the date of appointment and whenever so required by the Minister.
