The Inspectorate of Government (Terms and Conditions of Service for Staff) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001.

(Under section 25 of the Inspector-General of Government Statute 1988, Statute No. 2 of 1988).

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Inspector-General of Government by section 25 of the Inspector-General of Government Statute, 1988, these Regulations are made this 14th day of November, 2001.

1. (1) These Regulations may be cited as the Inspectorate of Government (Terms and Conditions of Service for Staff) (Amendment) Regulations, 2001.

Citation and commencement.

- (2) These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of July, 2000.
- 2. For subregulation (1) of regulation 39 of the Inspectorate of evernment (Terms and Conditions of Service for Staff) regulations, 2000, there is substituted the following subregulation—

"39. (1) A member of staff appointed on contract shall be paid a terminal gratuity at the rate of thirty percent of the total salary paid to him or her upon successful completion of the contract; and where the contract is not completed or if it is terminated, he or she shall be paid thirty per cent of the total salary for the period of time worked."
