


ALLOCATION TO MUNICIPALITIES NOT LISTED IN THE SCHEDULE OF PROVINCIAL GAZETTE NO. 1163 DATED 25 MAY 2004.

In terms of section 16(2) of the Division of Revenue Act 2004, a provincial accounting officer intending to make an allocation other than an allocation listed in any schedule to the Act, to a municipality from the provincial revenue fund must publish such information in a provincial gazette.
