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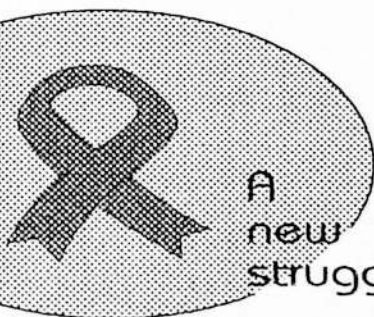

TRANSFER OF FUNDS FOR MUNICIPAL SPATIAL DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK IN TERMS OF DIVISION OF REVENUE ACT

In terms of section 16 (1) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2004, the accounting officer had made an allocation to various Municipalities from the Provincial Revenue Fund and published such information in a *provincial gazette*. Certain allocations under Spatial Planning Division were omitted i.e. funding for the preparation of a Spatial Development Framework for Inkwanca, Ikwezi, Gariep and Inxuba Yethemba Municipalities.

In view of the above, it is recommended that the following be transferred:

Inkwanca: R150 000,00.

Gariep: R150 000,00.

Inxuba Yethemba: R150 000,00.
