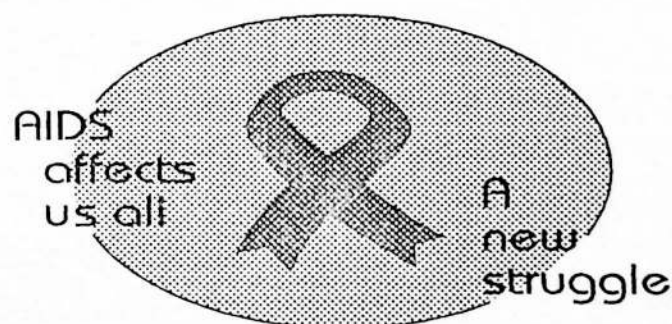



PROVINCE OF THE EASTERN CAPE**DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AFFAIRS, ENVIRONMENT & TOURISM****EASTERN CAPE LIQUOR ACT, 2003 (ACT NO 10 OF 2003)****AMENDMENT OF EASTERN CAPE LIQUOR REGULATIONS, 2004**

Under the powers vested in me by section 69 of the Eastern Cape Liquor Act, 2003 (Act No. 10 of 2003) (hereinafter "the Act"), I, ANDRE DE WET, in my capacity as member of the Executive Council responsible for the administration of the said Act in the Province hereby –

- (a) after consultation with the Eastern Cape Liquor Board amend the Eastern Cape Liquor Regulations contained in Provincial Notice No. 14 of 2004 promulgated on 08 April 2004 in Provincial Gazette No. 1143 (hereinafter " the Regulations") by the insertion after regulation 7 of regulation 7A as set out on the Schedule; and
- (b) determine in terms of section 69(e) of the Act that the public interest requires the above insertion to be made without delay; and
- (c) determine that the said regulations shall come into operation on the date of publication hereof.

SCHEDULE

The Regulations are hereby amended by the insertion after Regulation 7 of the following Regulation:

“Validity of temporary registration certificate

7A The Temporary registration certificates issued in terms of regulation 7 shall remain valid for a further period of six (6) months after the expiry of the initial period of twelve (12) months. The period for submission of applications for temporary registration certificates expires on publication of the regulations.”
