



APPROVED 2015 / 2016 ANNUAL BUDGET AND INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT PLAN

AMENDMENT TO RATES AND TARIFFS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Senqu Municipal Council has in terms of section 24 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, No 56 of 2003, approved its Annual Operational and Capital Budget on the 29th of May 2015. As required in terms of section 17 of the Municipal Finance Management Act, the Budget, Integrated Development Plan and Supporting Documents were tabled and advertised for representations / submissions by the local community, Provincial and National Treasury on the 7th of April 2015. All representations / submissions received before the 8th of May 2015 were dealt with by council where after an operational budget of R 197 522 273 and a capital budget of R 62 889 900 were approved. Copies of the approved 2015 / 2016 Annual Budget, Integrated Development Plan and supporting documents are available at the Lady Grey and Barkly East administrative units of Senqu Municipality and the Sterkspruit Office.

Refuse Removal tariffs would increase by 6.00% as from the 1st July 2015.

Electricity tariffs would increase by 14.24% from 1 July 2015 once approved by the National Energy Regulator (NER).

Council would with effect 1st July 2015 apply the following differentiated **Assessment (Property) Rate Tariffs**: with a 6% overall increase.
