Notice submission deadlines

Government Printing Works has over the last few months implemented rules for completing and submitting the electronic Adobe Forms when you, the customer, submit your notice request.

In line with these business rules, GPW has revised the notice submission deadlines for all gazettes. Please refer to the GPW website www.gpwonline.co.za to familiarise yourself with the new deadlines.

CANCELLATIONS

Don't forget!

Cancellation of notice submissions are accepted by GPW according to the deadlines stated in the table above. Non-compliance to these deadlines will result in your request being failed. **Please pay special attention to the different deadlines for each gazette.**

Please note that any notices cancelled after the cancellation deadline will be published and charged at full cost.

Requests for cancellation must be sent by the original sender of the notice and must accompanied by the relevant notice reference number (N-) in the email body.

AMENDMENTS TO NOTICES

take note!

With effect **from 01 October**, GPW will not longer accept amendments to notices. The cancellation process will need to be followed and a new notice submitted thereafter for the next available publication date.

CUSTOMER INQUIRIES



Many of our customers request immediate feedback/confirmation of notice placement in the gazette from our Contact Centre once they have submitted their notice – While GPW deems it one of their highest priorities and responsibilities to provide customers with this requested feedback and the best service at all times, we are only able to do so once we have started processing your notice submission.

GPW has a **2-working day turnaround time for processing notices** received according to the business rules and deadline submissions.

PROOF OF PAYMENTS

REMINDER

GPW reminds you that all notice submissions **MUST** be submitted with an accompanying proof of payment (PoP) or purchase order (PO). If any PoP's or PO's are received without a notice submission, it will be failed and your notice will not be processed.

When submitting your notice request to submit.egazette@gpw.gov.za, please ensure that a purchase order (GPW Account customer) or proof of payment (non-GPW Account customer) is included with your notice submission. All documentation relating to the notice submission must be in a single email.

A reminder that documents must be attached separately in your email to GPW. (In other words, your email should have an Adobe Form plus proof of payment/purchase order – 2 separate attachments – where notice content is applicable, it should also be a 3rd separate attachment).

REMINDER OF THE GPW BUSINESS RULES

- Single notice, single email – with proof of payment or purchase order.
- All documents must be attached separately in your email to GPW.
- 1 notice = 1 form, i.e. each notice must be on a separate form
- Please submit your notice **ONLY ONCE**.
- Requests for information, quotations and inquiries must be sent to the Contact Centre **ONLY**.
- The notice information that you send us on the form is what we publish. Please do not put any instructions in the email body.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that application for a bookmaker licence in terms of section 53 of the Gambling and Betting Act, 1997 (Act No. 5 of 1997) (Eastern Cape) (as amended), the particulars of which are set out in the Schedule hereunder, has been lodged with the Eastern Cape Gambling and Betting Board.

The application may be inspected by any person at the offices of the Eastern Cape Gambling and Betting Board, ECGBB Building, Quenera Park, Quenera Drive, Beacon Bay, East London and at the respective municipalities at which the premises on the schedule below are situated.

Any representations, including objections, petitions or comments shall be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer of the Board within one (1) month of the date of this notice, commencing on **29 March 2016 until 28 April 2016**.

All representations shall specify: the application to which the representations relates; in the case of an objection, the grounds on which the objection is founded; in the case of comment, full particulars or facts in substantiation thereof; the name, address, telephone and fax number of the person making the representations and a statement whether the person making the representations wishes to make oral representations when the application is heard.

A person lodging representations may show cause why the Board should determine that his or her identity should not be divulged.

The under-mentioned figures used in brackets in the Schedule have the following meanings:

- (1) = The name and address of the applicant;
- (2) = If the applicant is a company or other corporate body, the names of all persons who have a financial or other interest of 5% or more in the applicant;
- (3) = In the case of a company the initials and surnames of all directors of the company;
- (4) = The type of application applied for; and
- (5) = The address of the premises from which the applicant intends to operate from.
