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

PROVINCIAL NOTICE 194 OF 2017**OFFICE OF THE PREMIER****FORMULA FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF HOUSES OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS IN TERMS OF THE EASTERN CAPE TRADITIONAL LEADERSHIP AND GOVERNANCE ACT, 2017 (ACT NO.1 OF 2017)**

I, **Phumulo Masualle** Premier of the Province of the Eastern Cape, acting in terms of section 51 and 68 of the Eastern Cape Traditional Leadership and Governance Act, 2017 (Act No.1 of 2017), hereby determine the formula for the determination of the total number of members of each local house established in the Province, and a number of representatives of each local house in the in the Provincial House as set out in the schedule hereto.

PART: A**FORMULA FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MEMBERS OF EACH LOCAL HOUSE OF TRADITIONAL LEADERS**

1. The formula is informed by the number of traditional councils in a jurisdiction of a local municipality.
2. The formula also seeks to ensure each local house is broadly representative of recognised different traditional leadership positions and traditional councils. To achieve the goal of broadly representation, the jurisdictional area of local municipalities with traditional councils will be used as constituencies.
3. To ensure a cost-effective and efficient functioning local house, the number of traditional councils under jurisdiction of a local municipality is categorised in intervals commencing with 1-3 traditional councils, increasing exponentially by 3 in each following interval with the exception of the last interval as indicated herein under:

NUMBER OF TRADITIONAL COUNCILS	RATIO OF REPRESENTATION [number of members to be selected or elected from the total number of traditional councils under a local municipality]
1 – 3	number of representatives = 1
4 – 6	number of representatives = 2
7 – 9	number of representatives = 3
10 – 12	number of representatives = 4
15 and more	number of representatives = 5 and above

4. There must be at least one person representing the traditional councils falling within the jurisdictional area of each local municipality where there are such councils irrespective of the number of traditional councils within such jurisdictional area.
5. The application of this formula in respect of each local house is set out in part B hereof.
6. As a general principle, if during any calculations in terms of this formula the decimal is .5 the figure must be rounded off upwards.

PART: C**FORMULA FOR THE DETERMINATION OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF NUMBER OF REPRESENTATIVES OF A LOCAL HOUSE IN THE PROVINCIAL HOUSE**

1. The formula must determine the number of representatives from each local house to the Provincial House.
2. For the purpose of achieving a fair geographical representation of traditional councils under the jurisdiction of a local house, the number of representatives to be selected or elected from each local house, is to be calculated in terms of the representation ratio determined for each interval of the total number of traditional councils falling under the jurisdiction of a local house in accordance with the table below:

NUMBER OF TRADITIONAL COUNCILS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF A LOCAL HOUSE	RATI OF REPRESENTATIVES [number of senior traditional leaders to be selected or elected as representatives from each local house]
1 – 15	number of representatives = 2
16 – 29	number of representatives = 4
30 – 44	number of representatives = 5
45 – 59	number of representatives = 6
60 and more	number of representatives = 9

3. There must be at least two senior traditional leaders or representatives representing each local house in the Provincial House irrespective of the number of traditional councils falling under the jurisdiction of a local house.
4. The application of this formula in respect of representation of each local house is set out hereunder on the Annexures of this formula.
5. As a general principle, if during any calculations in terms of this formula the decimal is .5 the figure must be rounded off upwards.
