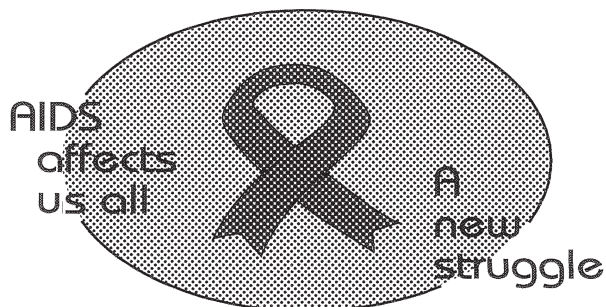

NOTICE OF DISSOLUTION OF OR TAMBO DISTRICT MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

I, **Xolile Nqatha**, Member of the Executive Council responsible for Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs in the Province of the Eastern Cape, in terms of section 34(4) of the Local Government: Municipal Structures Act, 1998 (Act No.117 of 1998), and duly authorised thereto by the Provincial Executive Council of the Eastern Cape, hereby give notice of dissolution of OR Tambo District Municipal Council in terms of section 139(1)(c) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 ("the Constitution").

Mr **Basil Mase** is hereby appointed as administrator of OR Tambo District municipality to act until a new Council has been declared elected. The administrator is hereby vested with all appropriate powers to ensure fulfilment of the obligations of the OR Tambo District municipality in terms of the Constitution and legislation.

In terms of section 139(3)(b) of the Constitution, the dissolution will take effect 14 days from the date of receipt of notice by Council unless set aside by the Cabinet member responsible for Local Government or National Council of Provinces before that date.
