CORRECTION OF INVITATION FOR LIMITED GAMBLING MACHINE SITE LICENCE APPLICATIONS NOTICE

The Free State Gambling and Liquor Authority established in terms of section 4 of the Free State Gambling and Liquor Act, 6 of 2012, (the "Act"), hereby replaces Provincial Notice No. 16 of 13 May 2011 as set out in the Schedule hereunder, so as to reflect its correct intention.

FREE STATE GAMBLING AND LIQUOR AUTHORITY INVITATION FOR LIMITED GAMBLING MACHINE SITE LICENCE APPLICATIONS

In terms of section 73(1) of the Free State Gambling and Liquor Act, 6 of 2010 ("the Act"), the Free State Gambling and Liquor Authority ("the Authority") herewith invites applications for Limited Gambling Machine Site Licences.

A Gambling Machine Site Licence shall authorize, subject to the provisions of the Act, the operation of and keeping in or on the licensed premises such number of gambling machines as specified in the licence, and for such purposes the holder of a gambling machine site licence shall enter into an agreement with the holder of a gambling machine operator licence for the placement of gambling machines on the premises concerned.

In terms of section 65 of the Act, any person may apply for a Gambling Machine Site Licence, subject to the provisions of sub-sections 65(1)(a) and (b) of the Act.

The Request for Application ("The RFA document") setting out the evaluation criteria to be applied as well as any other requirements for application, is available at the offices of the Authority, situated at 190 Nelson Mandela Drive, Bloemfontein at a fee of R5000.00.

The RFA shall furnish prospective applicants with a clear indication of the underlying principles applicable to the licensing of sites, as well as the process and criteria applicable to the licensing of applicants.

Applications must be lodged with the Chief Executive Officer of the Authority, at the above-mentioned address. The closing dates for the submission of applications are as set out in the schedule contained in the RFA, as may be amended from time to time.

Applications must be accompanied by:

- (a) Certified copies of the Applicant's notice of intention to apply, published in the *Provincial Gazette* and a newspaper circulation in the area, in which the premises where the gambling is to take place, are situated; and
- (b) All information which the Authority requires is in the RFA document.

The Board reserves the right not to grant any applications.
