I, EC Rockman, the MEC for Finance, acting in terms of section 30(3)(a) of the 2015 Division of Revenue Bill, hereby publish amendments to earmarked allocations which was made to Provincial Treasury in terms of Provincial Gazette No. 125 of 2015. These allocations were in line with the Appropriation Bill, 2015 that was tabled in the Free State Legislature on 11 March 2015 (Bill No. 3 of 2015).

Consequently, budget allocations in respect of transfers to municipalities and re-allocation of earmarked allocation to departments are set out in Schedule 1.
