- The farm Ontario No 663 Harrismith District in extent 331,3052 hectares;
- 6) The farm Chatsworth No 388 Harrismith District in extent 1614,5628 hectares;
- 7) The farm Bedford No 2 1845 Harrismith District in extent 877,7279 hectares;
- 8) Portion 6 of the farm Bedford No 389 Harrismith District in extent 877, 7273 hectares,

all located near the town of Harrismith within the Thabo Mofutsanyana District Municipality and the Phumelela Local Municipality of the Free State Province.
