

PROCLAMATION

by the

Premier of the Province of Gauteng

REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES OF MEMBERS OF THE PROVINCIAL LEGISLATURE

In terms of section 2 (1) of the Payment of Members of the Provincial Legislature Act, 1995 (Act No. 1 of 1995) (hereinafter referred to as the Act), and having given due regard to the recommendations of the Commission on Remuneration of Representatives published in Government Notice No. R. 1983 of 29 November 1996, I hereby determine that—

- (a) the annual remuneration and allowances to be paid to the various grades of members and office bearers of the Provincial Legislature shall be as set out in the attached Schedule;
- (b) the remuneration and allowances applicable to grades A2 to D1 shall be payable with effect from 1 January 1997; and
- (c) the remuneration and allowances applicable to grade E1 shall be payable with effect from 1 April 1997:

Provided that paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) shall apply only to a member who, on or after the date of this proclamation, is or becomes a member of the provincial legislature.

In terms of section 2 (3) of the Act, I hereby determine the amount of R40 000 per annum as that portion of the remuneration of a member of a Provincial Legislature to which paragraph (d) of section 8 (1) of the Income Tax Act, 1962 (Act No. 58 of 1962), shall apply with effect from 1 March 1997.

In this Proclamation, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Constitution or in the Rules and Orders contemplated in section 116 of the Constitution, shall bear that meaning, and

"Whip", means a Whip (other than the Chief Whip and Deputy Chief Whip of the Majority Party and the Chief Whip of the Largest Minority Party) for any political party represented in a House, designated by the leader of that party in that House, and approved in writing by the Speaker of the Provincial Legislature, as being reasonably necessary for the smooth working of Parliament.
