



NOTICE 3173 OF 2002

DECLARATION AS APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of section 69 of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1965 (Ordinance 25 of 1965), the Administrator hereby declares Northwold Extension 14 township to be an approved township, subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY DUNROSE 50 INVESTMENTS 50 (PROPRIETARY) LIMITED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1965, FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 275 (A PORTION OF PORTION 2) OF THE FARM BOSCHKOP NO. 199-I.Q., PROVINCE OF GAUTENG, HAS BEEN GRANTED

1. CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT

(1) NAME

The name of the township shall be Northwold Extension 14.

(2) DESIGN

The township shall consist of erven and streets as indicated on General Plan S.G. No. 6876/1997.

(3) STORMWATER DRAINAGE AND STREET CONSTRUCTION

(a) The township owner shall on request by the local authority submit to such authority for its approval a detailed scheme complete with plans, sections and specifications, prepared by a civil engineer approved by the local authority, for the collection and disposal of stormwater throughout the township by means of properly constructed works and for the construction, tarmacadamising, kerbing and channelling of the streets therein together with the provision of such retaining walls as may be considered necessary by the local authority.

(b) The township owner shall, when required by the local authority to do so, carry out the approved scheme at its own expense on behalf and to the satisfaction of the local authority under the supervision of a civil engineer approved by the local authority.

(c) The township owner shall be responsible for the maintenance of the streets to the satisfaction of the local authority until the streets have been constructed as set out in subclause (b).

(d) If the township owner fails to comply with the provisions of paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) hereof the local authority shall be entitled to do the work at the cost of the township owner.

(4) ENDOWMENT

The township owner shall, in terms of the provisions of section 63(1)(b) of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1965, pay, to the local authority, a lump sum as endowment of

(a) R56 865 - 13 for the provision of land for a park (public open space), and.

(b) R72 864 - 00 for the construction of Maple Drive.

Such endowment shall be payable in terms of section 73 of the said Ordinance.

(5) DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any, including the reservation of rights to minerals.

(6) ACCESS

No ingress from Provincial Road P103/1 to the township and no egress to Provincial Road P103/1 from the township shall be allowed.

(7) ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER

The township owner shall arrange for the drainage of the township to fit in with that of Road P103/1 and for all stormwater running off or being diverted from the road to be received and disposed of.

(8) DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

The township owner shall at his own expense cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority, when required by the local authority to do so.

2. CONDITIONS OF TITLE

The erven shall be subject to the following conditions imposed by the Administrator in terms of the provisions of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1965.

- (1) The erf is subject to a servitude, 2 m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2 m wide across the access portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.
- (2) No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large-rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2 m thereof.
- (3) The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the course of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.

KENNISGEWING 3173 VAN 2002**VERKLARING TOT GOEDGEKEURDE DORP**

Ingevolge artikel 69 van die Ordonnansie op Dorpsbeplanning en Dorpe, 1965 (Ordonnansie 25 van 1965), verklaar die Administrateur hierby die dorp Northwold Uitbreiding 14 tot 'n goedgekeurde dorp, onderworpe aan die voorwaardes uiteengesit in die bygaande Bylae.

VOORWAARDES WAAROP DIE AANSOEK GEDOEEN DEUR DUNROSE INVESTMENTS 50 (PROPRIETARY) LIMITED INGEVOLGE DIE BEPALINGS VAN DIE ORDONNANSIE OP DORPSBEPLANNING EN DORPE, 1965, OM TOESTEMMING OM 'N DORP TE STIG OP GEDEELTE 275 ('N GEDEELTE VAN GEDELTE 2 VAN DIE PLAAS BOSCHKOP NO. 199-I.Q., PROVINSIE GAUTENG, TOEGESTAAN IS

1. STIGTINGSVOORWAARDES**(1) NAAM**

Die naam van die dorp is Northwold Uitbreiding 14.

(2) ONTWERP

Die dorp bestaan uit erwe en strate soos aangedui op Algemene Plan L.G. No. 6876/1997.

(3) STORMWATERDREINERING EN STRAATBOU

- (a) Die dorpseienaar moet op versoek van die plaaslike bestuur aan sodanige bestuur 'n gedetailleerde skema, volledig met planne, deursneeë en spesifikasies, opgestel deur 'n siviele ingenieur wat deur die plaaslike bestuur goedgekeur is, vir die opgaar en afvoer van stormwater deur die hele dorp deur middel van behoorlike aangelegde werke en vir die aanlê, teermacadamisering, beranding en kanalisering van die strate daarin, tesame met die verskaffing van sodanige keermure as wat die plaaslike bestuur nodig ag, vir goedkeuring voorlê.
- (b) Die dorpseienaar# moet, wanneer die plaaslike bestuur dit vereis, die goedgekeurde skema op eie koste namens en tot bevrediging van die plaaslike bestuur, onder toesig van 'n siviele ingenieur deur die plaaslike bestuur goedgekeur, uitvoer.

- (c) Die dorpseienaar is verantwoordelik vir die instandhouding van die strate tot bevrediging van die plaaslike bestuur totdat die strate ooreenkomsdig subklousule (b) gebou is.
- (d) Indien die dorpseienaar versium om aan die bepalings van paragrawe (a), (b) en (c) hiervan te voldoen, is die plaaslike bestuur geregtig om die werk op koste van die dorpseienaar te doen.

(4) BEGIFTIGING

Die dorpseienaar moet, kragtens die bepalings van artikel 63(1)(b) van die Ordonnansie op Dorpsbeplanning en Dorpe, 1965, aan die plaaslike bestuur as begiftiging 'n globale bedrag van

- (a) R56 865 - 13 vir die verkryging van 'n park (openbare oopruimte), en.
- (b) R72 864 - 00 betaal vir die konstruksie van Maple Laan.

Sodanige begiftiging is betaalbaar kragtens die bepalings van artikel 73 van genoemde Ordonnansie.

(5) BESKIKKING OOR BESTAANDE TITELVOORWAARDES

Alle erwe moet onderworpe gemaak word aan bestaande voorwaardes en serwitute, as daar is, met inbegrip van die voorbehoud van die regte op minerale.

(6) TOEGANG

Geen ingang van Provinciale Pad P103/1 tot die dorp en geen uitgang tot Provinciale Pad P103/1 uit die dorp word toegelaat nie.

(7) ONTVANGS EN VERSORGING VAN STORMWATER

Die dorpseienaar moet die stormwaterdreinering van die dorp so reël dat dit inpas by dié van Pad P103/1 en moet die stormwater wat van die pad afloop of afgelei word, ontvang en versorg.

(8) SLOPING VAN GEBOUË EN STRUKTURE

Die dorpseienaar moet op eie koste alle bestaande geboue enstrukture wat binne boulynreserwes, kantruimtes of oor gemeenskaplike grense geleë is, laat sloop tot bevrediging van die plaaslike bestuur wanneer die plaaslike bestuur dit vereis.

2. TITELVOORWAARDES

Die erwe is onderworpe aan die volgende voorwaardes opgelê deur die Administrateur ingevolge die bepalings van die Ordonnansie op Dorpsbeplanning en Dorpe, 1965.

- (1) Die erf is onderworpe aan 'n serwituut 2 m breed, vir riolerings- en ander munisipale doeleinades, ten gunste van die plaaslike bestuur, langs enige twee grense, uitgesonderd 'n straatgrens en, in die geval van 'n pypsteelerf, 'n addisionele serwituut vir munisipale doeleinades 2 m breed oor die toegangsgedeelte van die erf, indien en wanneer verlang deur die plaaslike bestuur: Met dien verstande dat die plaaslike bestuur van enige sodanige serwituut mag afsien.
- (2) Geen gebou of ander struktuur mag binne die voornoemde serwituutgebied opgerig word nie en geen grootwortelbome mag binne die gebied van sodanige serwituut of binne 'n afstand van 2 m daarvan geplant word nie.
- (3) Die plaaslike bestuur is geregtig om enige materiaal wat deur hom uitgegrawe word tydens die aanleg, onderhou of verwydering van sodanige rioolhoofpyleidings en ander werke wat hy volgens goedgunke noodsaaklik ag, tydelik te plaas op die grond wat aan die voornoemde serwituut grens en voorts is die plaaslike bestuur geregtig tot redelike toegang tot genoemde grond vir die voornoemde doel, onderworpe daaraan dat die plaaslike bestuur enige skade vergoed wat gedurende die aanleg, onderhou of verwyderings van sodanige rioolhoofpyleidings en ander werke veroorsaak word.

NOTICE 3174 OF 2002**RANDBURG AMENDMENT SCHEME 2391**

The Administrator hereby, in terms of the provisions of Section 89 of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1965, declares that he approved an amendment scheme, being an amendment of Randburg Town-planning Scheme 1976, comprising the same land as included in the township of Northwold Extension 14.

Map 3 and the scheme clauses of the amendment scheme are filed with the Gauteng Provincial Government, (Department of Development Planning and Local Government), Johannesburg, and the Town Clerk Randburg, and are open for inspection at all reasonable times

The amendment is known as Randburg Amendment Scheme 2391.




