

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

### DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT, ROADS AND WORKS

#### GAUTENG PUBLIC PASSENGER ROAD TRANSPORT ACT (ACT NO.7 OF 2001)

#### NOTICE OF INTENTION TO MAKE REGULATIONS TO CLOSE TAXI ROUTES AND RANKS IN TERMS OF SECTION 93 (2) OF THE ACT IN THE AREA OF JURISDICTION OF EKURHULENI METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY.

I, **Khabisi Mosunkutu, Member of the Executive Council for Public Transport, Roads and Works in the Province of Gauteng**, having already declared the area of **Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality** as an area where it is, in my opinion, necessary to normalise the situation caused by violence, unrest and instability in the taxi industry and that it is in the interest of passengers and as the situation is still abnormal and as the closure of routes and ranks as mentioned hereinafter is in my opinion absolutely necessary to normalise the situation. I now give notice of my intention to make regulations in terms of section 93 (2) of the Act to close the routes and ranks as fully described in the schedule hereto.

Any person who wishes to make representations in respect of my intended action should do so in writing. Such representations should be sent **by fax to (011) 355 1575/ 9233 or (011) 355-7509**. Such representations should be made **on or before 12h00 on Monday 8th September 2003**.

From Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank via Heidelberg Road to old Vereening Road to Khumalo Street in Thokoza and return back to Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank with the same route.
- 1.1.2 GE0388 Zonkizizwe to Palmridge** described as follows;  
From Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank via Heidelberg Road to Rietfontein Road to Palmridge and back to Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank.
- 1.1.3 GE0389 Zonkizizwe to Vosloorus** described as follows;

From Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank via Heidelberg Road to Heidelberg Taxi Rank and return and return via the same route to Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank.

**1.1.12 GJ0210 Johannesburg to Dawn Park** described as follows; Klein Street, Bree

Street, End Street, Rockey Street, Sievwright, M2E, N3 Freeway Wadevill-Alrode, Old Heidelberg Rd, Brakpan Rd, Buhle Park, Klippoortjie, Windmill Park, Villa Liza Holomisa Park, Dawn Park Taxi Rank and back.

**1.2 RANKS**

**1.2.1 Zonkizizwe Taxi Rank**

Main Taxi Rank situated within Zonkizizwe Township.

2. Regulation 1 may be withdrawn earlier by a notice in the Government Gazette in a case of reports and information received indicating that the security situation of participants in the taxi industry as well as passengers in the above area has been normalized. In this regard reports in respect of the progress to reach an agreement between the various participants in the taxi industry, supported by satisfactory supporting mechanisms to ensure that discipline in the industry can practically be enforced, will be taken into account when the normality / abnormality of the situation and the question whether regulation is still necessary as assessed by the MEC for Public Transport, Roads and Works (Gauteng Provincial Government) on a daily basis.
