

Item 7: The supply to ---

- (a) a hospital patient classified in category H1, of assistive devices and prostheses: 25% of the cost of the relevant device or prosthesis, rounded to the nearest R5; and
- (b) a hospital patient classified in category H2, of assistive devices and prostheses: 75% of the cost of the relevant device or prosthesis, rounded to the nearest R5".

Application of regulations

- 5. The provisions of these regulations shall not apply to a person
 - (a) who is an in-patient on the day immediately preceding 1 February 2005; or
 - (b) whose admission and classification as an in-patient had been approved before 1 February 2005, and for the period ending on the date upon which he or she is discharged from the hospital concerned.

Short title and commencement

6. These regulations shall be called the Amendment Regulations relating to the classification of and fees payable by patients at provincial hospitals, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1 March 2005.

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
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
