EKURHULENI METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY HUGHES EXTENSION 51 TOWNSHIP

DECLARATION AS APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of the provisions of Section 103(1) of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986, the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality hereby declares Hughes Extension 51 Township situated on Portion 427 (A Portion of Portion 141) of the farm Driefontein 85 l.R. to be an approved township subject to the conditions set out in the schedule hereto:

SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY VOLVO (SOUTHERN AFRICA) (PROPRIETARY) LIMITED IN TERMS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE 15 OF 1986), FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 427 (A PORTION OF PORTION 141) OF THE FARM DRIEFONTEIN 85 I.R. HAS BEEN APPROVED.

CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT

1.1 NAME

The name of the township shall be Hughes Extension 51.

1.2 DESIGN

The township shall consist of erven and streets as indicated on General Plan S.G. No. 10991/2005.

1.3 DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any, including the reservation of rights to minerals, but excluding the following condition which does not affect the township area:

(a) Condition 3, as set out in Deed of Transfer No. T56824/2005.

1.4 DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

The township owner shall at its own expense cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the local authority, when required by the local authority to do so.

1.5 REMOVAL OR REPLACEMENT OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES

If, by reason of the establishment of the township, it becomes necessary to remove or replace any existing municipal services, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.6 OBLIGATIONS WITH REGARD TO ESSENTIAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The township owner shall within such period as the local authority may determine, fulfill its obligations in respect of the provision of water, electricity and sanitary services and the installation of systems therefore, as well as the construction of the roads and stormwater drainage system as previously agreed upon between the township owner and the local authority.

1.7 ENDOWMENT

The township owner shall, in terms of section 98(2) and (3) of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986, pay to the local authority a lump sum endowment of R1 419429.73 (VAT Inclusive and valid until 30 June 2006, whereafter the endowment will be revised) which amount shall be used by the local authority for the construction of streets and / or storm-water drainage in or for the township.

Such endowments are payable in terms of the provisions of section 81 of the said ordinance, read with section 95 thereof.

1.8 ACCESS

Ingress to the township and egress from the township shall not be permitted along National Road N12 and Provincial Road K105.

1.9 ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER

The township owner shall arrange for the drainage of the township to fit in with that of National Road N12 and Provincial Road K105 and for all stormwater running off or being diverted from the road to be received and disposed of.

1.10 ERECTION OF FENCE OR OTHER PHYSICAL BARRIER

The township owner shall at its own expense, erect a fence or other physical barrier to the satisfaction of the local authority, as when required by it to do so and the township owner shall maintain such fence or physical barrier in good order.

2. CONDITIONS OF TITLE

The erven shall be subject to the following conditions imposed by the local authority in terms of the provisions of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986.

2.1 ALL ERVEN

- 2.1.1 The erf is subject to a servitude, 2m wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any two boundaries other than a street boundary, and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2 m wide across the access portion of the erf when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.
- 2.1.2 No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large-rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2 m thereof.
- 2.1.3 The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the course of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.

2.2 ERF 346

- 2.2.1 Except for any essential storm-water drainage structure, no building, structure or other thing (including anything which is attached to the land on which it stands even though it does not form part of that land) shall be erected, laid or established on the erf or under or below the surface of the erf within a distance of 20m from the boundary of the erf abutting National Road N12, without the written approval of the South African Roads Agency Limited.
- 2.2.2 Ingress to and egress from the erf shall not be permitted along the boundary of the erf abutting on National Road N12.
