DECLARATION AS AN APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of Section 103(1) of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), the Ekurhuleni Metropolitan Municipality, Kempton Park Customer Care Centre hereby declares Glen Marais Extension 85 township to be an approved township subject to the conditions set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

STATEMENT OF THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY GLEN BALAD PROPERTIES CC (HEREINAFTER REFERRED TO AS THE APPLICANT/TOWNSHIP OWNER) UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PARTS A AND C OF CHAPTER 3 OF THE TOWN PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE 15 OF 1986), FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 181 OF THE FARM RIETFontein NO. 32, REGISTRATION DIVISION IR HAS BEEN GRANTED

1. CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT

1. NAME

The name of the township shall be Glen Marais Extension 85.

2. DESIGN

The township shall consist of erven and streets as indicated on SG Plan No. 313/2008.

3. DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any.

4. DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

The township owner shall at his own expense cause all existing buildings and structures situated within the building line reserves, side spaces or over common boundaries to be demolished to the satisfaction of the Local Authority, when required by the Local Authority to do so.

5. ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER

The township owner shall arrange for the drainage of the township to fit in with that of the existing and planned road and storm water infrastructure in the vicinity and for all storm water running off or diverted from the roads to be received and disposed of.

6. PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

(a) The township owner shall at his own expense, make arrangements with the local authority in order to ensure that:

- (i) water will not dam up, that the entire surface of the township area is drained properly and that streets are sealed effectively with tar, cement or bitumen; and
- (ii) trenches and excavations for foundations, pipes, cables or for any other purposes, are properly refilled with damp soil in layers not thicker than 150mm, and compacted until the same grade of compaction as that of the surrounding material is obtained;
- (iii) the recommendations as laid down in the geological report of the township are complied with and, when required, engineer certificates for the foundations of the structures must be submitted.

7. REMOVAL OF LITTER

The township owner shall at his own expense cause all litter within the township area to be removed to the satisfaction of the local authority, when required by the local authority to do so.

8. REPOSITIONING OF SERVICES

If, by reason of the establishment of the township, it should become necessary to reposition any existing services of Eskom, Telkom or the local authority, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

9. ENGINEERING SERVICES

- i) The applicant shall be responsible for the installation and provision of internal engineering services.
- ii) Once water, sewer and electrical networks have been installed, same will be transferred to the Municipality, free of cost, who shall maintain these networks (except internal street lights).

10. CONDITION TO BE COMPLIED WITH BEFORE THE ERVEN BECOME REGISTERABLE

The applicant shall at his own expense cause Erven 3424 and 3425 in the township to be consolidated.

2. CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be subject to the following conditions, imposed by the local authority in terms of the provisions of the Town Planning and Townships Ordinance 1986.

(1) ERVEN 3424 AND 3425

- (a) The erf is subject to a servitude, 2 metres wide, in favour of the local authority, for sewerage and other municipal purposes, along any one boundary other than a street boundary and in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes 2m wide across the access portion of the erf, if and when required by the local authority: Provided that the local authority may dispense with any such servitude.
- (b) No building or other structure shall be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no large-rooted trees shall be planted within the area of such servitude or within 2 metres thereof.
- (c) The local authority shall be entitled to deposit temporarily on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude such material as may be excavated by it during the course of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works as it, in its discretion may deem necessary and shall further be entitled to reasonable access to the said land for the aforesaid purpose, subject to any damage done during the process of the construction, maintenance or removal of such sewerage mains and other works being made good by the local authority.
