#### **NOTICE 144 OF 2009**

### **ELECTORAL COMMISSION**

#### **ELECTION TIMETABLE**

The Electoral Commission hereby gives notice that it has in terms of section 11 of the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000, compiled the election timetable set out below to apply to the municipal by-elections to be held on 28 January 2009 in respect of Ward 25 of the Mogale City [GT481] Municipality and Ward 19 of the City of Johannesburg [JHB] Municipality as proclaimed by Provincial Notice number 5363 of 2008 as published in the Provincial Gazette No. 343 of the Gauteng Province, dated 19 December 2008. A reference to "section" in this election timetable is a reference to that section in the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000 (Act No. 27 of 2000).

## Cut-off time for act to be performed

An act required in terms of this Act to be performed by not later than a date in the election timetable must be performed before 17:00 on that date, unless otherwise specified.

#### Certification of the voters' roll

By 9 January 2009 the chief electoral officer must certify the segments of the voters' roll for the voting districts to be used in the by-elections in terms of section 6(2)(a).

## Notice that lists of addresses of voting stations are available for inspection

3 By 9 January 2009 the chief electoral officer must give notice that copies of a list of voting stations and their addresses will be available for inspection at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 19(5).

### Notice of route of mobile voting stations

If the Commission decides to use mobile voting stations in the byelections, the Commission must by 9 January 2009 give notice of the route, including the locations and estimated times of stopping of each mobile voting station in terms of section 22(1).

## Cut-off date for nomination of ward candidates to contest an election

By not later than 15 January 2009 at 17h00, the nomination of a person to contest the by-election in a municipality as a ward candidate must be submitted to the Commission's local representative on a prescribed form and in the prescribed manner in terms of section 17(1).

# Cut-off date for compilation and certification of ward candidate lists

6 By 19 January 2009 the Commission must compile for each ward a list of ward candidates, certify those lists for that by-election, and keep copies of the lists available at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 18 (1).

## Cut-off date for issuing certificates

By 19 January 2009 the Commission must issue to each ward candidate contesting the by-election, a prescribed certificate in terms of section 18(1)(d).
