## CLOSURE OF AN ACCESS ROAD IN RESPECT OF PROVINCIAL ROAD P70-1: DISTRICT JOHANNESBURG

In terms of section 38 (5) of the Gauteng Transport Infrastructure Act, 2001 (Act No 8 of 2001) the MEC hereby proclaims the closure of an access road in respect of Provincial Road P70-1 on the land as described and indicated by the figure on the accompanying sketch plan.

Boundary beacons, demarcating the aforementioned closure of the road, have been placed on the land concerned and plans PRS 74/59/1V and PRS 72/48/6V indicating the closure of the road, in detail are available for inspection by any interested person during office hours at the office of the Department of Roads and Transport, Sage Life Building, 41 Simmonds Street, Johannesburg.
