Dumping facilities for vacuum tankers will be provided **only** at the Purification Works daily from Monday to Saturday during the hours 07h30 to 16h00 subject to the following conditions:-

- (i) All discharge/dumping fees will be payable in advance.
- (ii) Receipt of payment is not transferable to any other person or company.
- (iii) If the contents of the tanker can be classified as a prohibited discharge as provided for in Section 80 of the Standard Drainage By-laws, dumping/discharge will not be allowed.
- (iv) No industrial effluent will be received unless a representative sample is submitted to the Purification Works' laboratory prior to discharge. The discharge fee will be calculated in accordance with industrial effluent charges formula plus the cost of analysis and levied accordingly on the industry's monthly account.
- (v) No domestic or industrial effluent originating outside the municipality's area of jurisdiction will be accepted.


