

TSHWANE AMENDMENT SCHEME 404T

It is hereby notified in terms of the provisions of section 125(1) of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance 15 of 1986), that the City of Tshwane has approved an amendment scheme with regard to the land in the township of Die Wilgers Extension 87, being an amendment of the Tshwane Town-planning Scheme, 2008.

DECLARATION OF DIE WILGERS EXTENSION 87 AS APPROVED TOWNSHIP

In terms of Section 103 of the Town-planning and Townships Ordinance, 1986 (Ordinance No 15 of 1986), the City of Tshwane hereby declares the township of Die Wilgers Extension 87 to be an approved township, subject to the conditions as set out in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE APPLICATION MADE BY O T VENTER INVESTMENTS CLOSE CORPORATION UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER III: PART C OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE NO 15 OF 1986), FOR PERMISSION TO ESTABLISH A TOWNSHIP ON PORTION 147 OF THE FARM HARTEBEESTPOORT 362JR, PROVINCE OF GAUTENG, HAS BEEN GRANTED

- 1. CONDITIONS OF ESTABLISHMENT
 - 1.1 NAME

The name of the township shall be Die Wilgers Extension 87.

1.2 DESIGN

The township shall consist of erven and streets as indicated on General Plan SG No 3473/2013

1.3 DISPOSAL OF EXISTING CONDITIONS OF TITLE

All erven shall be made subject to existing conditions and servitudes, if any, including the reservation of the rights to minerals, but -

1.3.1 Excluding the following Condition II in Deed of Transfer T39845/2012, which does not affect the township:

"A SERVITUDE for road building purposes, measuring approximately 2631 square metres, has been expropriated by the CITY OF TSHWANE METRO-POLITAN MUNICIPALITY vide Notice of Expropriation EX60/2003."

1.3.2 Excluding the following Condition III in Deed of Transfer T39845/2012, which will not be passed on to the erven in the township:

"By virtue of Notarial Deed of Servitude K6501/2008S dated 6th November 2007, the within mentioned property is entitled to a servitude of right of way over the remaining extent of Portion 34 of the farm Hartebeestpoort 362JR, 10 metres wide, parallel to the Northern boundaries of the above-mentioned serviant property, as will more fully appear from the said Notarial Deed."

1.4 ACCESS

Unless the consent in writing of the Head of the Department: Gauteng Provincial Government: Department of Public Transport, Roads and Works has been obtained, no ingress from Provincial Road K34 to the township and no egress to Provincial Road K34 shall be allowed.

1.5 RECEIVING AND DISPOSAL OF STORMWATER

The services report containing the stormwater design proposals has been approved by the Gauteng Department of Public Transport, Roads and Works.

1.6 REMOVAL OR REPLACEMENT OF MUNICIPAL SERVICES

Should it become necessary to move or replace any existing municipal services as a result of the establishment of the township, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.7 CONSOLIDATION OF ERVEN

The township owner shall at his own expense have Erven 1382 and 1383 in the township consolidated. The City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality hereby grants its consent to the consolidation in respect of Section 92(2) of Ordinance 15 of 1986.

1.8 DEMOLITION OF BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES

When required by the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality to do so, the township owner shall at his own expense cause to be demolished to the satisfaction of the Municipality, all existing buildings and structures (if any) situated within building line reserves and side spaces or over common boundaries, or dilapidated structures.

1.9 ERECTION OF FENCE OR OTHER PHYSICAL BARRIER

The township owner shall at his own expense erect a fence or other physical barrier to the satisfaction of the Head of the Department: Gauteng Provincial Government: Department of Public Transport, Roads and Works, as and when required by him to do so, and the township owner shall maintain such fence or physical barrier in a good state of repair until such time as the erven in the township are transferred to ensuing landowners, after which the responsibility for the maintenance of such fence or physical barrier rests with the latter.

1.10 REMOVAL OF LITTER

The township owner shall at his own expense have all litter within the township area removed to the satisfaction of the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality, when required to do so by the Municipality.

1.11 REMOVAL AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF ESKOM POWER LINES

Should it become necessary to remove and/or replace any existing power lines of Eskom as a result of the establishment of the township, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.12 REMOVAL AND/OR REPLACEMENT OF TELKOM SERVICES

Should it become necessary to remove and/or replace any existing TELKOM services as a result of the establishment of the township, the cost thereof shall be borne by the township owner.

1.13 COMPLIANCE WITH CONDITIONS IMPOSED BY GDACE

The township owner shall at his own expense comply with all the conditions imposed, by which the Gauteng Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Environment including if applicable those by which exemption has been granted from compliance with Regulations No 1182 and 1183 promulgated in terms of Sections 21, 22 and 26 of the Environmental Conservation Act, (Act 73 of 1989) or the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act 107 of 1998) and Regulations thereto, as the case may be, for the development of this township.

1.14 NATIONAL HERITAGE RESOURCE ACT

The township owner shall at his own expense comply with the provisions of the National Heritage Resource Act, 25 of 1999.

2. CONDITIONS OF TITLE

2.1 THE ERVEN MENTIONED BELOW SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE CONDITION AS INDICATED, LAID DOWN BY THE CITY OF TSHWANE METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY IN TERMS OF THE PROVISIONS OF THE TOWN-PLANNING AND TOWNSHIPS ORDINANCE, 1986 (ORDINANCE 15 OF 1986)

2.1.1 ALL ERVEN

- 2.1.1.1The erf shall be subject to a servitude, 2m wide, for municipal services (water, sewer, electricity and stormwater) (hereinafter referred to as "the services"), in favour of the Municipality, along any two boundaries, excepting a street boundary and, in the case of a panhandle erf, an additional servitude for municipal purposes, 3m wide, over the entrance portion of the erf, if and when required by the Municipality: Provided that the Municipality may waive any such servitude.
- 2.1.1.2No buildings or other structures may be erected within the aforesaid servitude area and no trees with large roots may be planted within the area of such servitude or within a distance of 2m from thereof.
- 2.1.1.3The City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality shall be entitled to temporarily deposit on the land adjoining the aforesaid servitude, any material it excavates during the laying, maintenance or removal of such services and other works which in its discretion it regards necessary, and furthermore the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality shall be entitled to reasonable access to the said property for the aforesaid purpose, subject to the provision that the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality shall make good any damage caused during the laying, maintenance or removal of such services and other works.

2.1.2 ERF 1382

Erf 1382 shall be subject to a 3m wide servitude on part of the western boundary of the township for Municipal services (sewerage and stormwater), in favour of the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality, as indicated on the township layout plan.
