DETERMINATION OF A TSHWANE RAPID TRANSIT (A RE YENG) BUS FEEDER NETWORK ROUTES AND THE A RE YENG FEEDER BUS STOPS FOR THE PRETORIA CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT (CBD) AND HATFIELD AREA.

Notice is hereby given, in terms of section 65*bis* (2) of the Local Government Ordinance 17 of 1939, read with sections 21 and 21A of the Local Government: Municipal Systems Act 32 of 2000 that the City of Tshwane Metropolitan Municipality has:

- approved the amendment of the Clockwise and Anticlockwise feeder route and stopping places;
- approved a Clockwise Muckleneuk feeder route and stopping places;
- approved four proposed feeder routes and stopping places to be added to the A Re Yeng feeder route network from the Central Business District (CBD) to Hatfield, covering the areas of Muckleneuk/Groenkloof, Pretoria CBD, and Sunnyside; and
- approved three bus/taxi interchange points as indicated below:

Feeder Route Five: Pretoria CBD Clockwise feeder**Route:**

Bus departs from Nana Sita Station situated in Nana Sita Street in a westerly direction and turn left into Sisulu Street, proceed and turn left into Jeff Masemola Street, proceed with Jeff Masemola Street into Rissik Street. Proceed with Rissik Street and turn right into Troye Street, continue and turn right into Justice Mahomed Street, proceed with Justice Mahomed Street into Scheiding Street, proceed with Scheiding Street and turn right into Bosman Street. Proceed with Bosman Street and turn left into Jeff Masemola Street, continue and turn right into Kgosi Mampuru Street and proceed up to Belle Ombre Station (Platform 3, Pankop/Bultfontein Stop). Proceed from Belle Ombre Station with Sophie de Bruyn Street and turn left into Boom Street, continue with Boom Street into Edmond Street, proceed with Edmond Street and turn right into Nelson Mandela Drive, proceed with Nelson Mandela Drive and turn right into Nana Sita Street and up to Nana Sita Station situated in Nana Sita Street.
