#### ELECTORAL COMMISSSION

#### **ELECTION TIMETABLE**

THE Electoral Commission hereby gives notice that it has in terms of section 11 of the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000, compiled the election timetable set out below to apply to the municipal by-elections to be held on 27 September 2006 in respect of Ward 4 of the KwaDukuza Municipality [Stanger - KZ292] as proclaimed by Provincial Notice No. 1523 of 2006 as published in the KwaZulu-Natal *Provincial Gazette* No. 6505 dated 1 September 2006. A reference to "section" in this election timetable is a reference to that section in the Local Government: Municipal Electoral Act, 2000 (Act No. 27 of 2000).

### Cut-off time for act to be performed

 An act required in terms of this Act to be performed by not later than a date in the election timetable must be performed before 17:00 on that date, unless otherwise specified.

## Certification of the voters' roll

2. By 7 September 2006 the Chief Electoral Officer must certify the segments of the voters' roll for the voting districts to be used in the by-elections in terms of section 6(2)(a).

### Notice that lists of addresses of voting stations are available for inspection

3. By 7 September 2006 the Chief Electoral Officer must give notice that copies of a list of voting stations and their addresses will be available for inspection at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 19(5).

#### Notice of route of mobile voting stations

4. If the Commission decides to use mobile voting stations in the by-elections, the Commission must by 7 September 2006 give notice of the route, including the locations and estimated times of stopping of each mobile voting station in terms of section 22(1).

## Cut -off date for nomination of ward candidates to contest an election

5. By not later than 14 September 2006 at 17h00, the nomination of a person to contest the by-election in a municipality as a ward candidate, must be submitted to the Commission's local representative on a prescribed form and in the prescribed manner in terms of section 17(1).

## Cut - off date for compilation and certification of ward candidate lists

6. By 15 September 2006 the Commission must compile for each ward a list of ward candidates, certify those lists for that by-election, and keep copies of the lists available at the office of the Commission's local representative in terms of section 18(1).

#### Cut-off date for issuing certificates

 By 27 September 2006 the Commission must issue to each ward candidate contesting the by-election, a prescribed certificate in terms of section 18(1)(d).
