

It is hereby notified that the Premier has assented to the following Act which is hereby published for general information.

**No. 6 of 2009 : Northern Cape Youth Commission Act Repeal Act, 2009**

**NORTHERN CAPE YOUTH COMMISSION ACT REPEAL ACT, 2009**

**ACT**

To provide for the disestablishment of the Northern Cape Youth Commission and for the transfer of its employees, assets and liabilities; to repeal the Northern Cape Youth Commission Act, 2005; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

BE IT ENACTED BY the Provincial Legislature of the Province of the Northern Cape, as follows:—

**1. Definitions**

In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise –

"the Act" means the Northern Cape Youth Commission Act, 2005 (Act 1 of 2005);

"chairperson" means the Chairperson of the Commission appointed in terms of section 3 of the Act;

"CEO" means the Chief Executive Officer of the Commission appointed in terms of section 9 of the Act;

"Commission" means the Northern Cape Youth Commission, established by the Act.

"Premier" means the Premier of the Northern Cape Province elected in terms of section 128 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996.

**2. Disestablishment of the Northern Cape Youth Commission**

The Commission established in terms of section 2 of the Act, is hereby disestablished.

**3. Transitional Provisions**

- (1) When this Act comes into operation -
  - (a) all assets, rights, obligations and liabilities of the Commission are vested in the Office of the Premier without payment of any transfer duties, stamp duties, fees or taxes;
  - (b) the employees of the Commission must be transferred to the Northern Cape Provincial Administration subject to applicable provisions of the Labour Relations Act, 1995 (Act No. 66 of 1995),
  - (c) relevant provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999) must have been complied with
- (2) The Accounting Officer in the Office of the Premier in consultation with the CEO and the chairperson are responsible for the finalization of all matters of the Commission.
- (3) The Premier may issue directives in so far as may be necessary to give effect to the provisions of this section

**4. Repeal Laws**

The whole of the Northern Cape Youth Commission Act, 2005 (Act 1 of 2005) is hereby repealed.

**5. Short title and commencement**

- (1) This Act is called the Northern Cape Youth Commission Act Repeal Act, 2009 and comes into effect on a date proclaimed by the Premier in the *Provincial Gazette*.
  - (2) Different commencement dates may be determined by the Premier for the coming into operation of the different provisions of this Act.
