

- Phase 3: Analysis of Spatial Development Patterns and Spatial Interpretation of Land-Use and Land Development Patterns, Socio-Economic Trends and Environmental Patterns;
- Phase 4: Preparation of the Draft !Kheis Spatial Development Framework;
- Phase 5: Achieving Support by the Community, Government Departments and the Private Sector for the Draft Spatial Development Framework, which will include the advertisement of the Draft Spatial Development Framework and a Public Comment Period; and
- Phase 6: Finalisation and Approval of the !Kheis Spatial Development Framework by the Municipal Council.
