

- 1 An allowance has been made for the inclusion of discounts for Pensioners meeting certain criteria. The discount is proposed at 50%.
- 2 Public Service infrastructure is no longer feasible to rate due to the regulated rating ratios. It is therefore zero (0) rated.
- 3 Differentiation in the tariffs for the categories "Agricultural Properties" have been included to introduce greater parity within this sector whereby recognition of agriculture, business and residential activities have been made in relation to each other.
- 4 The 2011/2012 financial year saw the implementation of the General Valuation Roll 2011.
- Property rates payers for all categories of property will receive a 10% discount on their rates account if paid in full by the due date of the current account. This discount will be given per month. Annual rate payers will receive a 10% discount if their rates are paid in full by the due date for payment of the annual rates. No discounts will be given if there are any arrears on the account.
