

This reviewed PSDF 2020 will replace the current Northern Cape Provincial Spatial Development Framework 2012 entirely. The PSDF 2020 is a spatial representation and framework to achieve the Provincial Vision and Objectives, drivers of change and different paths of prosperity contained in the Provincial Growth and Development Plan 2020.
