

**NORTHERN CAPE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT  
DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM  
NORTHERN CAPE GAMBLING ACT, 2008 (ACT NO. 3 OF 2008)  
GAMBLING REGULATIONS**

1. In terms of Section 89(2) of the above, Act, I, Abram Vosloo, Member of the Executive Council of the Northern Cape Province responsible for Finance, Economic Development and Tourism, hereby publish draft for the amendment of regulations as was gazetted in gazette No 1389, published on 26 March 2010, Notice No 17 of 2010 for public comment in the government gazette.

**The details of the proposed amendments to the regulations are as follows:**

- 1) Regulation 7(c) of the Northern Cape Gambling Act regulations is hereby amended by substituting sub-regulation (c) thereof as follows;**

**"7.** The Board may not issue a license to an applicant if the premises from which the licensed activities will take place are **[in the opinion of the Board]** –

...

- (c) on or premises which are within 100 m **[500 m]** of a school or an existing place of worship."

- 2) Regulation 7 of the Northern Cape Gambling Act regulations is hereby amended by the addition of a new regulation thereto as follows;**

**"7A.** 1. Despite the provision of sub-regulation 7(c) the Board may exercise a discretion to issue a license to an applicant whose premises are within 100m of a school or a place of worship provided that –

**RESTRICTED**

- a) The applicant provides a letter of consent from the school governing body, or the church council or committee stating the days and time such applicant's activities may be allowed to take place.
- b) The applicant may produce a letter from the local municipality confirming that a place of worship within the radius affecting the applicant's application is non-operational.
2. The distance of 100m as provided under sub-regulation 7(c) must be measured by using any acceptable measuring wheel that is approved in terms of the South African Bureau of Standards from the main entry point of a school or church to the entry point of the premises where the applicant's activities will take place.

- 2) Regulation E of the Northern Cape Gambling Act regulations' fee schedule is hereby amended by the addition of the underlined amount and the deletion of the words within square brackets [] marked in bold, under the Bingo license fees as follows;

**"E. FEES FOR BINGO IN TERMS OF THE ACT AND REGULATIONS**

<p><input type="checkbox"/> The holder of a bingo operator license will pay to the Board on issuing of the license and thereafter before 1 April of each year, <u>an amount of R27 500 plus</u> a license fee of R100 per licensed seat <u>or Bingo terminal</u> for every following fiscal year or part thereof ending on 31 March</p>

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**Invitation to lodge objections or representations**

1. Interested persons are hereby invited to lodge representations or comments for the proposed amendments of the regulations by no later than 15:30 on the 07<sup>th</sup> December, 2023.
2. Representations, objections and comments should be in writing and must contain at least the following information:
  - (a) The objection or representation which relates to amendment,
  - (b) The ground(s) on which objections or representations are made, and
  - (c) The name, address and telephone number of the person submitting the representations.
3. Any representations that do not contain all the information referred to in paragraph 2 above, will be deemed not to have been lodged with the Department and will not be considered by the Department.
