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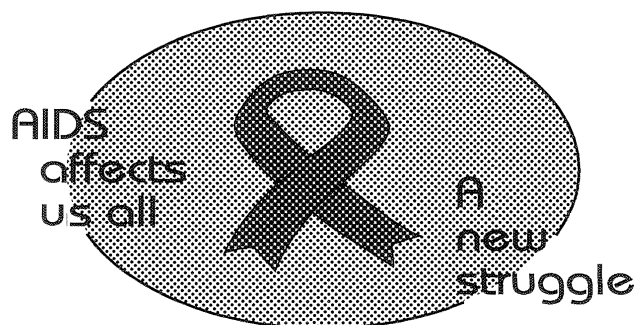

**DETERMINATION REGARDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW
PROVINCIAL DEPARTMENTS AND ALLOCATION AND TRANSFER OF
FUNCTIONS FROM ONE DEPARTMENT TO ANOTHER**

Pursuant to the 2014 National and Provincial elections, I, **Supra Obakeng Ramoeletsi Mahumapelo**, in my capacity as the Premier of the North West Province, have reconfigured the provincial departments as a result of which the structure and composition of government departments became affected.

In terms of section 137 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 read with Section 3A(b) of the Public Service Act, 1994 (Proclamation no. 103 of 1994), I have determined the establishment of new departments including the transfer and allocation of functions between departments as set out in the schedule below:



Department of Education	<p>Department of Education and Sports Development</p> <p>This Department has undergone name change from Department of Education to Department of Education and Sports Development</p> <p><i>The function of Sports has now been transferred from the former Department of Sports, Arts and Culture to be integrated into the above mentioned Department.</i></p>
Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism	<p>Department of Economy and Enterprise Development</p> <p>This Department has undergone name change from Department of</p>
