

NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 41(1) OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO. 57 OF 2002): DECLARATION OF PROVINCIAL STATE OF EARTHQUAKE DISASTER IN THE PROVINCE OF NORTH WEST.

By virtue of the powers vested in me in terms of section 41(1) of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002), after consultation with the other MECs and in consideration of the provisions of paragraphs (a) and (b) of section 41(1) of that Act, I hereby, for areas listed in the Schedule hereto, declare a provincial state of disaster, to —

- (a) assist and protect the public:
- (b) provide relief to the public;
- (c) protect property;
- (d) prevent and combat disruption; as well as
- (e) dealing with the destructive and other effects of the disaster.

Section 41 of the Disaster Management Act provides that -

- "(1) In the event of a provincial disaster, the Premier of the province, after consultation with the other MECs, may, by notice in the provincial gazette, declare a provincial state of disaster if
 - (a) Existing legislation and contingency arrangements do not adequately provide for the provincial executive to deal effectively with the disaster; or
 - (b) other special circumstances warrant the declaration of a provincial state of disaster.".
