I, G.T.V Tlhapi, Member of the Executive Council responsible for the Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism, hereby invite nominations of persons in terms of Section 7(5) of the North West Parks & Tourism Board Act (No. 2 of 2022), within 21 days from the date of this publication of this notice, to be appointed as members of the board in terms of Section 7(7)(a) of the Act

The North West Parks and Tourism Board is a public entity to the Department and a Schedule 3C entity in terms of the Public Finance Management Act (No. 1 of 1999 as amended). Its focus is on ensuring the establishment, development and efficient management of a network of formally protected areas in order to conserve indigenous Biodiversity, representative samples of natural ecosystems and habitats of critically important or threatened species.

Prospective Board members must demonstrate the ability to guide the executive management through the development of appropriate strategies and policies to ensure proper governance of the entity. Members of the board, when viewed collectively must be South African citizens, who should be fit and proper to serve the best interests of the province, be characterized by their independence, impartiality and fairness and must collectively possess:

- Legal Skills, experience and qualifications
- Financial skills, experience and qualifications
- Extensive knowledge and expertise in Business Management including Human Resources Management and Labour Relations
- Extensive knowledge and experience in Biodiversity, Conservation and Tourism
- Any other skill, experience or qualification that might be of benefit to the Board

All nominations must be in writing and be accompanied by a nominee's formal indication of his or her acceptance of such nomination, as well as a comprehensive Curriculum Vitae, certified copies of academic qualifications and identity document of the nominee, full names and address, contacts and email address of the institution and/or individual making the nomination.
