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WESTERN CAPE GAMBLING AND RACING RULES**GENERAL NOTICE**

Under the powers vested in me by section 82 of the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Law, 1996 (Law 4 of 1996), I, Derrick William Auret, in my capacity as chairperson of the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board, hereby make the rules as set out hereunder.

STORAGE AND MANUFACTURER PERMITS FOR GAMBLING DEVICES

Sections 84A and 84B of the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Law, 1996 (Law 4 of 1996), as amended, provides for interim measures relating to the possession and manufacture of gambling devices without the appropriate licence. The procedure to be followed is set out below.

1. Advertising

- 1.1 The Chief Executive Officer shall, by notice in the *Provincial Gazette* and at least two other newspapers distributed in the Province, invite persons who, prior to the date of the notice, were in possession of or manufactured gambling devices in the Province without the appropriate licence. These persons shall approach the Board to obtain the necessary application forms for storage and manufacturer permits. The forms shall be substantially in the form as set out in Annexures A and B.
- 1.2 All applications shall be returned to the offices of the Board within twenty-eight days of the date of the notice together with a payment of R570,00 per application.

2. Application

- 2.1 The applicant shall indicate on the application form whether it is his or her intention to apply for a casino operator licence, a limited gambling machine operator licence, a distributor licence or a manufacturer licence or whether it is his or her intention to dispose of the gambling devices in his or her possession. If it is the applicant's intention to dispose of the gambling devices, he or she shall indicate to whom and in what manner.
- 2.2 An applicant for a manufacturer permit shall indicate on the application form to whom he or she distributes or intends to distribute gambling devices.
- 2.3 An application shall not be considered unless the application forms are completed in full and payment of R570,00 has been received.

3. Issuing of permits

- 3.1 Permits, each with an appropriate serial number, shall be issued to an applicant after receipt of the completed application forms and prescribed fee. The permits shall be issued as soon as possible after the due date for the submission of the application forms.
- 3.2 The permits shall be issued subject to the terms and conditions of sections 84A(3) and 84B(2) of the Law.

4. Disposal of gambling devices

- 4.1 A holder of a permit shall, before disposing of his or her gambling devices, apply to the Board for approval of such disposal.
- 4.2 The holder of a permit shall indicate to the Board how he or she intends to dispose of the gambling devices, which gambling devices, whether the gambling devices are to be transferred to another party, the name and address of the other party and the date of disposal of the gambling devices.
- 4.3 The holder of a permit shall, within ten working days after the date of disposal of the gambling devices referred to in paragraph 4.2, supply the Board with documentary proof of such disposal.

Applications must be accompanied by either a bank cheque or a bank guaranteed cheque, made out in favour of the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board, in the amount of R570-00 per application, a certified true copy of the applicant's identity document or the identity document of the person nominated to exercise physical control on behalf of a corporate body or partnership. Where applicable, a certified true copy of the registration certificate of the corporate body or partnership must also be submitted.

2. A "manufacturer" means every person who imports, acquires, manufactures, assembles, maintains, repairs, alters, distributes, leases or sells slot machines or any other gambling device or any component thereof, but not playing cards or dice.
3. Application forms must be completed by the manufacturer of the gambling devices concerned, including where the gambling devices are manufactured by a corporate body or partnership, in which case such corporate body or partnership must nominate one of its members as the applicant who will physically control the manufacture of the gambling devices.
4. All applications must be submitted in the format set out below, either typed or clearly printed in black.
