Die Wes-Kaapse Wet op Dobbeldary en Wedrenne, 1996 (Wet 4 van 1996) is op 29 Augustus 1997 in die *Provinsiale Koerant* afgekondig.

Ingevolge artikel 50 van die Wet, soos gewysig, is 'n vervaardigerlisensie 'n vereiste vir elke persoon wat muntoutomate of enige ander dobbeltoestel of komponent daarvan, maar nie speelkaarte of dobbelstene nie, invoer, aanskaf, vervaardig, monteer, in stand hou, herstel, verander, verhuur of verkoop vir gebruik in hierdie Provinsie.

Ingevolge artikel 51 van die Wet, soos gewysig, is 'n verspreiderlisensie 'n vereiste vir elke persoon wat muntoutomate of enige ander dobbeltoestel of stelsel wat daarmee in verband staan, maar nie speelkaarte of dobbelstene nie, regstreeks of onregstreeks invoer, aanskaf, versprei, bemark, verhuur of verkoop vir gebruik in hierdie Provinsie.

Vir die doeleindes van beide artikels 50 en 51 word een of meer van die volgende 'n "dobbelttoestel" geag te wees:

- Dobbeldarymasjiene
- Roulette wiele
- Tekenmunte of ander instrumente van waarde
- Rekenaar bestuurstelsels
- Gerekenariseerde dobbeldary-, moniterings-, bestuurs- en rekenkundige stelsels
- Roulette balle en Blackjack en Punto Banco skoene
- Big Six wiele en verwante montering
- Nootbevestigings
- Munt- of nootverspreiders
- Moniteringstelsels
- Roulette tafelluitlegte
- Blackjack tafelluitlegte
- Craps tafelluitlegte
- Baccarat tafelluitlegte
- Punto Banco tafelluitlegte
- Tafelluitlegte vir ander spele wat in casino's gespeel word

Albei lisensie word slegs uitgereik aan:

- 'n Maatskappy geregistreer ingevolge die Wet op Maatskappye, 1973, of
- 'n Beslote Korporasie ingevolge die Wet op Beslote Korporasies, 1984.

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WESTERN CAPE GAMBLING AND RACING BOARD

NOTICE

APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A MANUFACTURER OR
DISTRIBUTOR LICENCE

The Western Cape Gambling and Racing Law, 1996 (Law 4 of 1996) was proclaimed in the *Provincial Gazette* on 29 August 1997.

In terms of section 50 of the Law, as amended, a manufacturer licence is required by any person who imports, acquires, manufactures, assembles, maintains, repairs, alters, distributes, leases or sells slot machines or any other gambling device or any component thereof, but not playing cards or dice, for use in this Province.

In terms of section 51 of the Law, as amended, a distributor licence is required by any person who, directly or indirectly imports, acquires, distributes, markets, leases or sells any gambling device or related system, but not playing cards or dice, for use in this Province.

For the purpose of both sections 50 and 51, a "gambling device" is considered to be one or more of the following:

- Gambling machines
- Roulette wheels
- Chips, tokens and other value instruments
- Computer management systems
- Computerised gambling, monitoring, management and accounting systems
- Roulette balls and Blackjack and Punto Banco Shoes
- Big Six Wheels and related assembly
- Bill validator
- Coin/Note dispensing machines
- Surveillance systems
- Roulette table layouts
- Blackjack table layouts
- Craps table layouts
- Baccarat table layouts
- Punto Banco table layouts
- Other casino game layouts

Either licence shall only be issued to:

- a company registered in terms of the Companies Act, 1973 or
- a close corporation registered in terms of the Close Corporations Act, 1984.

Entities who are interested in obtaining either licence, should contact the Western Cape Gambling and Racing Board to obtain the necessary application forms. The application forms must be completed and returned to the Board before 16:00 on 24 October 1997, accompanied by a payment of R5 700,00 per application.
