- (b) herroep ek artikel 4A van die Verteenwoordigende Oorgangsraade Maatreël, 1996 (Proklamamsie 18 van 1996) met ingang van 1 Julie 1997.

## SKEDULE

1. Deur artikel 8 en 8.1 deur die volgende te vervang.

## “Berekening van toelaes

8 (1) Onderworpe aan die bepalings van Subartikel (2), (4), (5) en (6) en artikel 11, sal die toelae betaalbaar aan 'n lid van die Kaapse Metropolitaanse Raad en die metropolitaanse oorgangssubstrukture ingestel ingevolge artikel 7(1)(6) van die Wet, 'n distrikraad ingestel ingevolge artikel 9 van die Wet, 'n plaaslike oorgangsraad en 'n verteenwoordigende oorgangsraad wees soos uiteengesit word in Tabel 3 in ooreenstemming met die waarde in die eerste kolom van die Tabel wat vir elke raad bereken word in ooreenstemming met die volgende formule:

$$a + b,$$

waar "a" 'n waarde is in die eerste kolom van Tabel 1 wat aan daardie raad toegestaan is gebasbeer op die inkomste uit belasting van daardie raad.

en "b" is 'n waarde in die eerste kolom van Tabel 2 wat aan daardie raad toegestaan is gebasbeer op die aantal kiesers aangedui in die tweede kolom van Tabel 2, wat vir daardie raad geregistreer is: Met dien verstande dat enige raad wat nie in staat is om die toelaes in Tabel 3 uiteengesit te bekostig nie, met die goedkeuring van die verantwoordelike lid van die provinsiale uitvoerende raad die betaling van toelaes teen 'n verminderde bedrag, kan goedkeur.

- (2) Vir die doel van hierdie Bepaling word "inkomste van tariewe" as volg gedefinieer:

“Die werklike inkomste van tariewe van 'n plaaslike owerheid vir die vorige finansiële jaar soos bereken deur elke plaaslike owerheid aan die einde van die onmiddelik voorafgaande finansiële jaar. Op voorwaarde dat dit aanvaar kan word dat hierdie bedrag nie op daardie tydstip ge-ouditeer sou wees nie.”

- (3) Indien 'n raadslid in 'n metropolitaanse substruktuur sowel as die Kaapse Metropolitaanse Raad in watter hoedanigheid ookal dien, is hy/sy slegs geregtig op die toelae wat van toepassing is op 'n posisie ander dan die van 'n gewone raadslid en is sy of haar toelae by die ander raad beperk tot twee keer die toelae van toepassing op 'n gewone raadslid.

- (4) (a) Lede van die Kaapse Metropolitaanse Raad wat nie direk tot die raad verkies is, sal volgens die vlakke bepaal vir kategorie 16 in Tabel 3 betaal word.

## PROVINCE OF WESTERN CAPE:

LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSITION ACT, 1993  
(ACT 209 OF 1993)AMENDMENT OF ENACTMENT REGARDING THE REMUNERATION  
OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES

Under section 10N(4) of the Local Government Transition Act, 1993 (Act 209 of 1993), and with the concurrence of the Minister of Provincial Affairs and Constitutional Development, I hereby—

- (a) amend the Schedule to Proclamation 82 of 12 May 1993 as amended by Proclamation 102 of 1 September 1993 and Proclamation 29 of 24 November 1997.
- (b) with effect from 1 July 1997 repeal section 4A of the Transitional Representative Councils Enactment, 1996 (Proclamation 18 of 1996).

This Proclamation shall come into operation on 1 July 1997.

## SCHEDULE

1. The following section is hereby substituted for section 8 and 8.1.

## “Calculation of Allowances

8 (1) Subject to the provisions of Subsection (2), (4), (5) and (6) and section 11, the allowance payable to a member of the Cape Metropolitan Council and the transitional metropolitan substructures established in terms of section 7(1)(b) of the Act, a district council established in terms of section 9 of the Act, a transitional local council and a transitional representative council shall be as set out in Table 3 in accordance with the value in the first column of that Table which is calculated for each council in accordance with the following formula:

$$a + b,$$

where "a" is a value in the first column of Table 1 which is accorded that council based on the income from rates for that council.

and "b" is a value in the first column of Table 2 which is accorded that council based on the number of voters indicated in the second column of Table 2, registered for that council: Provided that any council which is unable to afford the allowances set out in Table 3 may, with the approval of the responsible member of the provincial executive council, approve the payment of allowances in a lesser amount.

- (2) For the purpose of this Enactment “income from rates” is defined as follows:

“The actual income from rates of a local authority for the previous financial year as calculated by each local authority at the end of the immediately preceding financial year. Provided that it be accepted that this amount will not have been audited at that time.”

- (3) If a councillor serves in a metropolitan substructure as well as the Cape Metropolitan Council in whatever capacity, he is entitled to receive from only one council, the allowance applicable to a position other than that of a ordinary councillor and his or her allowance at the other council is limited to twice the allowance applicable to an ordinary councillor.

- (4) (a) Members of the Cape Metropolitan Council who have been directly elected to the council shall be paid according to the levels stipulated for category 16 in Table 3.

- (b) Members of the Councils of the Transitional Metropolitan

(5) Lede van die Verteenwoordigende Oorgangsrade sal toelaes betaal word volgens die vlakte bepaal vir kategorie 1 in Tabel 3.

(6) Die Voorsitters van die distrikrade sal betaal word in ooreenstemming die vlakte bepaal vir vlak 1 van kategorie 14 in Tabel 3.

(7) Raadslede wat op distrikrade dien sal ten opsigte van vergaderings bygewoon by die distrikraad geregtig wees op 'n toelae per vergadering in terme van die skale soos hieronder uiteengesit op voorwaarde dat vergaderingtoelaes vir 'n maksimum van tien vergaderings per jaar geëis kan word.

2. Artikel 9 word hierby geskrap.

3. Artikel 11 word hierby deur die volgende artikel vervang:

#### "Spesiale voorwaardes

11 (1) Waar die bestaande vergoeding plus byvoordele die bestaande vergoeding oorskry, behou die betrokke raadslede die hoër besoldigingsvlak op voorwaarde dat geen verdere aanpassings gemaak word totdat die normale aanpassings wat in hierdie Proklamasie vervat is gelyk is aan die toelae wat huidiglik aan daardie raadslede betaal word, waarna verdere aanpassings weer op hulle van toepassing sal wees, op voorwaarde dat: In die geval van munisipaliteite wat tussen 1 Januarie tot 30 Junie 1997 verhogings in raadslidtoelaes goedkeur het, sodanige verhogings teruggetrek moet word indien dit die toepaslike vlakte van vergoeding in Tabel 3 oorskry.

(2) Die huidige stelsel van pensioenvoordele van toepassing op 30 Junie 1997 vir raadslede word behou, in afwagting van die ondersoek na hierdie voordele, maar op voorwaarde dat geen nuwe lede toegelaat word om by bestaande fondse aan te sluit nie waar die toestemming van 'n funksionaris van die staat of provinsiale regering vereis word om by die fonds aan te sluit nie.

(3) Die huidige reëlings vir reisuitgawes van toepassing op raadslede wat ten opsigte van raadsaangeleenthede reis en raadslede in plattelandse gebiede wat raadsvergaderings bywoon, word behou, op voorwaarde dat—

(a) raadslede normaalweg geen vergoeding vir reisuitgawes binne die regsgebied van die betrokke raad ontvang nie,

(b) raadslede wat buite die regsgebied van hul rade reis en lede van distrikrade wat buite die regsgebied van die primêre plaaslike owerheid ten opsigte van distrikraadsaangeleenthede reis, vir ampelike besoekbevoordeeld konferensies en vergaderings, redelike vergoeding ontvang vir werklike onkostes soos reisonkostes, maaltye en hotelkostes, en

(c) in die geval van raadslede wat in plattelandse gebiede dien, word raadslede wat meer as 30km moet reis om Raadsvergadering by te woon, vergoed ten opsigte van vervoer na en van vergaderings van die Raad.

(4) In uitsonderlike gevalle waar die betaling van besoldiging van toepassing is op raadslede wat in raadskomitees dien, word daardie reëlings behou: Met dien verstande dat hiedie beginsel nie uitgebrei word voordat 'n nuwe bedeling vir plaaslike regering in werking tree nie.

(5) 'n Raad moet deur middel van 'n besluit boetes bepaal wat

Substructures of Cape Town and Tygerberg shall be paid according to the levels stipulated for category 16 in Table 3.

(c) Members of the Council of the Transitional Metropolitan Substructures of the South Peninsula shall be paid according to the levels stipulated for category 15 of Table 3.

(d) Members of the Councils of the Transitional Metropolitan Substructures of Helderberg, Blaauwberg and Oostenberg shall be paid according to the levels stipulated for category 14 in Table 3.

(5) Members of transitional representative councils shall be paid allowances stipulated for category 1 in Table 3.

(6) The Chairperson of district councils shall be paid in accordance with the stipulation for level 1 of category 14 in Table 3.

(7) Councillors serving on district councils shall, in respect of meetings attended at the district council, be entitled to an allowance per meeting in terms of the scales provided below, but on condition that meeting allowances for a maximum of ten meetings can be claimed per year.

2. Section 9 is hereby deleted.

3. The following section is hereby substituted for section 11.

#### "Special provisions

11 (1) Where the existing remuneration plus benefits exceed the above remuneration, the councillors concerned retain such higher level of payment, on condition that no further adjustments be made until the normal adjustments contained in this Proclamation is equal to the allowance currently being paid to those councillors, whereafter further adjustments will again be applicable to them provided that: In the case of municipalities meeting approved increases in councillor remuneration between 1 January to 30 June 1997, such increases be reversed should they exceed the applicable levels of remuneration in Table 3.

(2) The system of pension benefits for councillors pertaining on 30 June 1997 is retained pending the investigation of those benefits but on condition that no new members be allowed to join the existing funds where the permission of a government or provincial government functionary is required in order to join the fund.

(3) The present arrangements for travelling expenses in respect of councillors travelling on council business and councillors in rural areas attending council meetings pertaining on 30 June 1997 are retained on condition that—

(a) councillors ordinarily do not receive compensation for travelling expenses within the area of jurisdiction of the council concerned;

(b) councillors who travel outside the area of jurisdiction of their council, and members of district councils who travel outside the area of jurisdiction of the primary local authority, on the business of the district council, on official visits such as conferences and meetings, receive reasonable compensation for out of pocket expenses such as travelling expenses, meals and hotel costs, and

(c) in the case of councillors serving the rural areas, councillors required to travel in excess of 30 kilometers to attend council meetings, be compensated for expenses relating to transport to and from meetings of the council.

(4) In exceptional cases where the payment of remuneration for councillors serving on council committees are in operation, those arrangements be retained: Provided that such arrangements not be further extended until a new dispensation for local governments comes into existence.

(5) A council shall by resolution institute fines payable by
