GAZETTING OF ALLOCATIONS TO MUNICIPALITIES AS CONTAINED IN THE WESTERN CAPE ADJUSTED ESTIMATES, 2008 AND WHICH WERE NOT PUBLISHED IN THE DIVISION OF REVENUE ACT, 2008 (ACT NO.2 OF 2008)

WESTERN CAPE PROVINCIAL TREASURY

I, Garth Strachan, in my capacity as Provincial Minister of Finance, Economic Development and Tourism hereby publish the attached schedule in terms of section 31(3)(a) of the Division of Revenue Act, 2008 (Act No.2 of 2008) (2008 DORA) which stipulates, amongst others, that a Provincial Treasury may, in accordance with a framework determined by National Treasury, amend the allocations made to municipalities in terms of section 31(2) of DORA or make additional allocations to municipalities that were not published in terms of subsections (1) and (2) of DORA. These are amended and/or additional allocations to those allocations made in terms of the 2008 Main Budget (Estimates of Provincial Expenditure) which were gazetted in Gazette No. 6505 dated 4 March 2008. These allocations have been taken up in the Western Cape Adjustments Appropriation Bill, 2008.
