MAKSIMUM PRYSE VAN SUIKER.

Ek, Heinrich Rudolph Philip August Kotzenberg, Prys-kontroleur, handelende kragtens regulasie 3 van Oorlogsmaatreël No. 49 van 1946, bepaal hierby vir die hele Unie, met uitsondering van Suidwes-Afrika en die hawe en nedersetting Walvisbaai soos volg:—

1. Behoudens die bepalings van die Eerste Bylae hiervan, is die maksimum prys waarteen die goedere gespesifiseer in die Tweede Bylae hiervan deur enigeen, uitgesonderd die fabrikant van sodanige goedere, aan 'n handelaar verkoop mag word, die prys wat gespesifiseer word in, of berekenbaar is ooreenkomsdig die betrokke bepalings van, voorname Tweede Bylae.

2. Behoudens die bepalings van die Eerste Bylae hiervan, is die maksimum prys waarteen die goedere gespesifiseer in die Derde Bylae hiervan, uitgesonderd in die geval van 'n verkoop waarop die bepalings van paragraaf 1 hiervan van toepassing is, deur enigeen aan iemand anders verkoop mag word, die prys wat gespesifiseer word in, of berekenbaar is, ooreenkomsdig die betrokke bepalings van, voorname Derde Bylae.

3. Vrystelling van die bepalings van paragrawe 1 en 2 word aan handelaars verleen ten opsigte van die verkoop van suiker wat by die meul verpak is in houers van minder as 50 lb., op voorwaarde dat suiker wat nie aldus verpak is nie aan enigiemand wat dit wil koop volgens voorskrif van genoemde paragrawe verkoop word.

4. Die volgende Goewermenskennisgewing, soos gewysig, met betrekking tot die maksimum prys van kruideniersware word hierby ingetrek, naamlik:—

OPMERKINGS.—(1) Die doel van hierdie kennisgewing is om alle wysigings van Goewermenskennisgewing No. 1069 van 25 Julie 1958 te konsolideer en om voorsiening te maak vir die maksimum prys van goudbruin-suiker.

(2) Die reg om 'n winsmarge waarvoor in enige van die Bylaes van hierdie kennisgewing voorsiening gemaak word, by te voeg, is onderworpe aan die bepalings van regulasie 6 van Oorlogsmaatreël No. 49 van 1946.

PRICE CONTROL.

MAXIMUM PRICES OF SUGAR.

Acting in terms of regulation 3 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946, I, Heinrich Rudolph Philip August Kotzenberg, Price Controller, hereby prescribe for the whole Union, excluding South West Africa and the port and settlement of Walvis Bay, as follows:—

1. Subject to the provisions of the First Schedule hereto, the maximum prices at which the goods specified in the Second Schedule hereto may be sold by any person, other than the manufacturer of such goods, to a dealer, are the prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with the relevant provisions of, the said Second Schedule.

2. Subject to the provisions of the First Schedule hereto, the maximum prices at which the goods specified in the Third Schedule hereto may, except in the case of a sale to which the provisions of paragraph 1 hereof are applicable, be sold by any person to any other person, are the prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with the relevant provisions of, the said Third Schedule.

3. Exemption from the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 is granted to dealers in respect of the sale of mill-packed sugar packed in containers of less than 50 lb., on condition that sugar not thus packed shall be sold in terms of the provisions of the aforementioned paragraphs to any person who wishes to purchase it.

4. The following Government Notice, as amended, relating to the maximum prices of groceries is hereby withdrawn, namely:—

NOTES.

(1) The purpose of this notice is to consolidate all amendments of Government Notice No. 1069 of 25th July, 1958, and to provide for the maximum prices of golden brown sugar.

(2) The right to add any profit margin for which provision is made in any of the Schedules to this notice, is subject to the provisions of regulation 6 of War Measure No. 49 of 1946.

EERSTE BYLAE.

WOORDBEPALINGS EN VERTOLKINGS.

Tensy anders vermeld, is die volgende omskrywings en vertolkings van toepassing by die berekening van maksimum prys ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van die Tweede en Derde Bylae:—

1. 'n Plek wat uitdruklik genoem word, beteken die gebied onder regsbevoegdheid van die plaaslike bestuur op dié plek en omvat alle plekke binne vyf myl van die grens van dié gebied.

2. „Witwatersrand” beteken die gebied onder dieregsbevoegdheid van die plaaslike besture van Alberton, Alexandradorp, Benoni, Boksburg, Brakpan, Edenvale, Germiston, Johannesburg, Kempton Park, Krugersdorp, Nigel, Randfontein, Roodepoort-Maraisburg en Springs, en omvat alle plekke binne vyf myl van die grens van die gebiede onder dieregsbevoegdheid van die plaaslike besture van die plekke so pas genoem.

3. (a) Afstande moet bereken word deur die mylafstand te neem van die kortste spoorwegroete van die aangegewende poorwegstasie af vanwaar die betrokke goedere gewoonlik verkry word na die spoorwegstasie of -halte waarheen dit gewoonlik gestuur word, plus die kortste mylafstand per pad van laasgenoemde spoorwegstasie of -halte af na die plek van verkoop: Met dien verstande dat waar goedere gewoonlik per pont en/of onderworpe aan 'n ordering vir so 'n diens vervoer word, die afstand per pad aldus berekenbaar met 50 myl vermeerder kan word.

(b) Die mylafstand van die kortste spoorwegroete word bereken ooreenkomsdig Byvoegsel No. 3 by Offisiële Spoorwegtariefboek No. 26: Met dien verstande dat enige sodanige afstand wat (i) van Port Elizabeth af bereken is, met een myl verminder moet word, of (ii) van Durban, Oos-Londen of Kaapstad af bereken is, met twee myl verminder moet word.

(c) Waar in die Derde Bylae hiervan voorsiening gemaak word vir toelaes ten opsigte van padvervoerkoste, is die afstande wat gespesifiseer word, berekenbaar met verwysing na die naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte en mag in geen geval die afstand van sodanige spoorwegstasie of -halte af na die plek van verkoop oorskry nie.

4. Die uitdrukking „naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte” beteken die spoorwegstasie of -halte waarheen die goedere versend word, maar sluit Padmotordiensstasies of -haltes uit.

5. Die uitdrukking „kleinhandelprys”, het betrekking op 'n prys berekenbaar ooreenkomsdig die Derde Bylae, en die uitdrukking „groothandelprys” beteken 'n prys berekenbaar ooreenkomsdig die Tweede Bylae.

6. Behalwe waar anders bepaal, word 'n breuk van 'n pennie in die maksimum prys by die verkoop op een en dieselfde tydstip van suiker, waarop hierdie kennisgewing betrekking het, hetsy dit die prys van 'n enkele eenheid is in die geval van 'n verkoop van die enkele eenheid, of die totale prys verkry by die berekening van die prys wat van toepassing is op enige aantal van sulke eenhede in die geval van 'n verkoop van meer as een eenheid, as dit minder as 'n halfpennie is, as 'n halfpennie, en, as dit meer as 'n halfpennie is, as 'n pennie beskou.

7. Die maksimum groothandelpryse gespesifiseer in, of berekenbaar ooreenkomsdig die bepalings van, die Tweede Bylae het betrekking op onoogpamedaakte verpaktings soos deur die fabrikant gelewer.

8. Die bepalings van die Derde Bylae met betrekking tot toelaes vir padvervoer, is nie in Zoeloeland van toepassing nie. Die toelaes vir padvervoer wat bygevoeg kan word by die maksimum kleinhandelpryse van suiker in Zoeloeland verkoop op plekke wat meer as vyf myl van die naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte geleë is, moet bereken word teen 'n halfpennie per lb. in die geval van plekke wat meer as vyf myl maar hoogstens vyftig myl van die naaste spoorwegstasie of -halte geleë is, en teen een pennie per lb. in die geval van plekke wat meer as vyftig myl van sodanige stasie of -halte geleë is.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATIONS.

Unless otherwise stated, the following definitions and interpretations apply in the determination of maximum prices in accordance with the provisions of the Second and Third Schedules:—

1. A place specifically named means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authority at such place and includes all places within five miles of the boundary of such area.

2. "Witwatersrand" means the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authorities of Alberton, Alexandra Township, Benoni, Boksburg, Brakpan, Edenvale, Germiston, Johannesburg, Kempton Park, Krugersdorp, Nigel, Randfontein, Roodepoort-Maraisburg and Springs and includes all places within five miles of the boundary of the area falling under the jurisdiction of the local authorities of the places just mentioned.

3. (a) Distances must be calculated by taking the mileage of the shortest railway route from the named railway station from which the goods in question are usually obtained to the railway station or siding to which they are generally consigned, plus the mileage of the shortest distance by road from the lastmentioned railway station or siding to the place of sale: Provided that, where goods are normally transported by pont and/or subject to a charge for such service, the road distance thus determinable may be increased by fifty miles.

(b) The mileage of the shortest railway route shall be determined in accordance with Supplement No. 3 to Official Railway Tariff Book No. 26: Provided that any such distance calculated (i) as from Port Elizabeth shall be reduced by one mile, or (ii) as from Durban, East London or Cape Town shall be reduced by two miles.

(c) Wherever in the Third Schedule hereto provision is made for allowances in respect of road transportation costs, the distances specified are determinable by reference to the nearest station or siding and shall in no case exceed the distance from such railway station or siding to the place of sale.

4. The expression "nearest railway station or siding" means the station or siding to which the goods are consigned, but excludes Road Motor Service stations or halts.

5. The expression "retail price" refers to a price determinable in accordance with the Third Schedule, and the expression "wholesale price" means a price determinable in accordance with the Second Schedule.

6. Except where otherwise provided, any fraction of a penny in the maximum price for a sale, at any one time, of sugar to which this notice relates, whether it be the price of a single unit in the case of a sale of such single unit or the total price resulting from the computation of the price applicable to any number of such units in the case of a sale of more than one unit, shall, if less than a halfpenny, be regarded as a halfpenny and, if more than a halfpenny, be regarded as a penny.

7. The maximum wholesale prices specified in, or determinable in accordance with the provisions of, the Second Schedule relate to unbroken packages as supplied by the manufacturer.

8. The provisions in the Third Schedule relating to allowances for road transportation shall not apply in Zululand. The allowance for road transport that may be added to the maximum retail prices of sugar sold in Zululand at places that are more than five miles from the nearest railway station or siding, shall be calculated at the rate of a halfpenny per lb. in the case of places that are more than five miles but not more than fifty miles from the nearest railway station or siding and at the rate of a penny per lb. in the case of places that are more than fifty miles from such a station or siding.

4. The maximum prices applicable in the Orange Free State are those specified in sub-item 2 (a), less 2d. per 100 lb., plus railage and cartage from Durban, regardless of the point of despatch). When Edgecombe No. 1 refined sugar is sold free on rail Mount Edgecombe, the said prices shall be reduced by the amount of any rebate received from the sellers, this varying from nothing to 3d. per pocket: Provided that at places at which, prior to the date of publication of this notice, sugar supplies have customarily been obtained by rail from or via East London, the maximum prices shall be calculated in terms of sub-item 1 (c) read with sub-item 1 (g) (iii), i.e. East London prices, plus railage and cartage from East London. When the sale is *ex* the seller's store and the sugar is railed on to the purchaser, the prices determinable in accordance herewith are free on rail seller's station.
